INDIANAPOLIS, Ind.—In what promises to be one of the most brilliant spectacles ever presented, veterans of World Wars I and II will march in a mammoth victory parade during the 28th national convention of The American Legion, which will be staged in San Francisco, Cal., September 30 to October 4, inclusive, it was announced here today by National Adjutant Donald G. Glascoff.

At least 100,000 visitors will flock to San Francisco for the parade and a renewal of its annual National Tournament of Music, plans for the 1946 national convention indicate.
