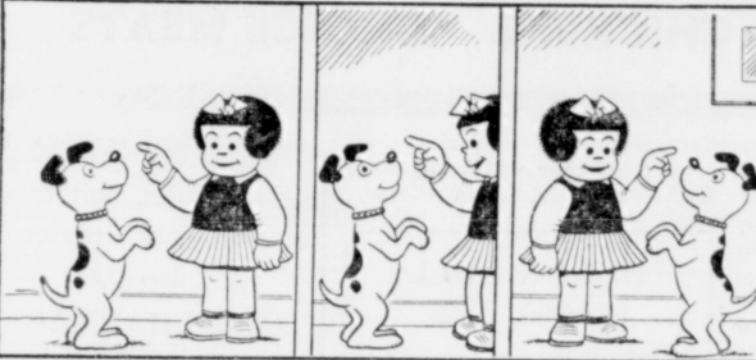

Toad Skins Medicinal

Historians report that many centuries ago the Chinese used dried and powdered skins of toads as a treatment for wounds. This ancient practice was considered a silly superstition until recently, when it was found that powdered toad skins contain a considerable amount of the modern drug adrenalin.

Omelets Same

Whether it's flat omelets, fluffy omelets, the ingredients are the same. One or two eggs for each person, 1 tablespoon of milk for each egg, and salt and pepper to taste. To make omelets fluffy, beat the egg yolks and whites separately. For a flat omelet, beat all ingredients together.

Volcanic Eruption

Krakatau volcano, in Sunda strait between Java and Sumatra, lay dormant from 1680 to 1883, then put on an extremely violent eruption that darkened and flooded Batavia, 100 miles away. The eruption completely changed the form of the three islands of the Krakatau group and created several new islets.

Aluminum Ware

Heavy "cast" aluminum vessels are made by pouring the molten metal into castings or forms. "Stamped" aluminumware is made from sheets of the metal. The sheet is rolled out and the pots and pans are stamped by cutter from the metal and then pressed into shape. "Stamped" aluminumware comes in three grades—light, medium and heavy.

Stainless Steel Pans

Stainless steel is more durable than aluminum of the same weight and thickness. It does not darken in cooking alkaline foods as aluminum does, but, once darkened by overheating or scorching, it can not be brightened as aluminum can. Aluminum has the advantage of spreading heat more evenly, so cooks more evenly with less chance of scorching.

Protect Stockings

To keep splinters from catching stockings, paint the edge of your desk or chair with colorless nail polish, or cover the nicks with scotch tape.

Bolster Chair Seats

If your cane chair seats have begun to sag, shrink them tight by washing with hot water and drying outdoors.
