phones, a third of its railroad lines, 60% of its life insurance and 80% of the world's automobiles.

The United States has one radio for every three people; Russia has one for every 90 people. In Russia there is one automobile for every 252 persons; in Italy one for every 93 people; in Sweden one for every 29; in Great Britain one for every 22; in France on automobile for every 18 citizens, but in the United States we have one automobile for every four people.

Much is heard of the alleged "security" provided by Britain's socialism, Russia's communism, or the experimental "isms" in other countries. How about security in the good old U.S.A.? In Italy the life insurance owned per individual averages \$36; in France \$49; in Germany \$117; in Sweden \$254; in Great Britain \$353; and in the United States \$842. Furthermore, the American worker earns twice as much as big a market basket of groceries as the British worker for the same amount of time; three times as much as the German worker; four times the Italian worker; and seven times the Russian worker.

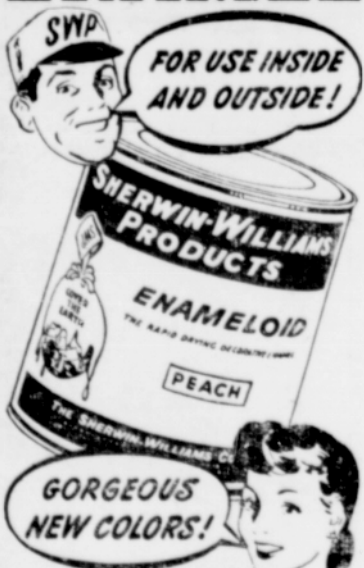
