



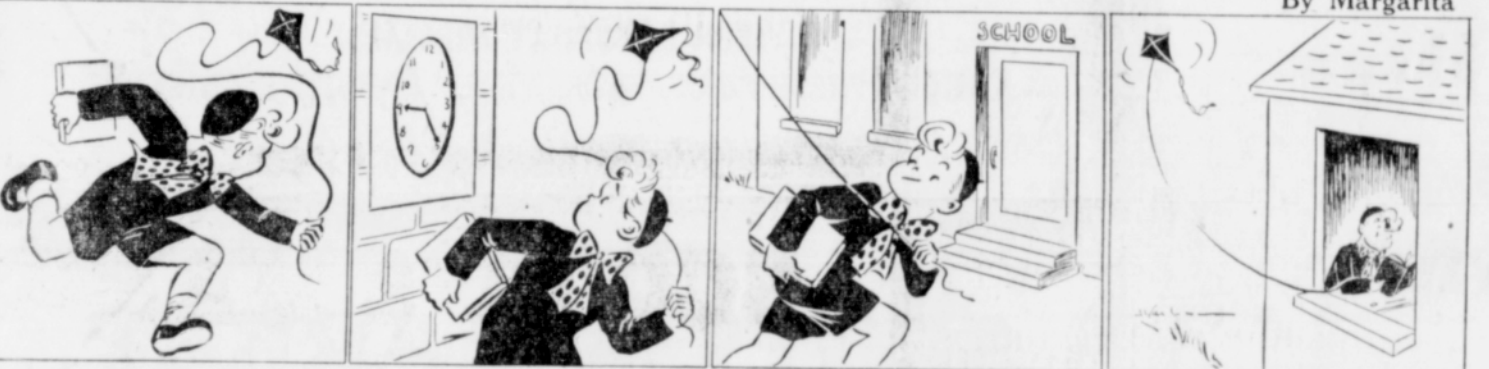

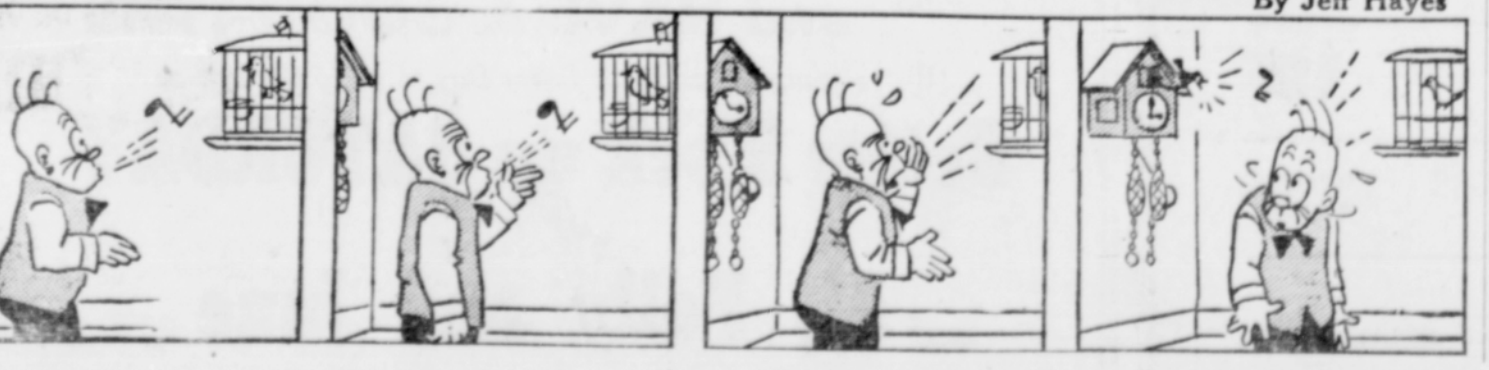

Quality Eggs

A newly laid egg that is not cooled quickly and handled carefully may lose its "fresh" qualities in a day or two.

Blanching Vegetables

During blanching, vegetables lose some of their nutritive value—some of the water-soluble vitamins and minerals.

Haying Dangerous

Haying season is one of the most dangerous on farms from the standpoint of accidents.

Painted Woodwork

Waxing painted woodwork will protect the surface from dirt and make it easier to clean.

Holds Vitamins

Less vitamin C (ascorbic acid) content will slip away from cabbage if it is kept in the refrigerator.

Lamb Loss

Approximately one-third of lambs born never reach the market. Better care at lambing time, proper rations and parasite control will help to reduce these losses.

Cultivate Grapes

At least 1,500 varieties of grapes are cultivated in Europe. The grape is supposed to have been indigenous to Asia.

Chinese Rockets

Rockets, using an explosive closely resembling gunpowder, were used by the Chinese 1,000 to 2,000 years B. C.

Airing Woollens

When hanging woolen clothes (on hangers) out on a line to air, place two strong clothespins between each two hangers. They'll keep the hangers from crowding to the center of the line, so clothes will air thoroughly.

Window Glass

Although man invented glass about 9,000 years ago, according to the Encyclopaedia Britannica, he didn't invent window glass until more than 7,000 years later. First mentions of window glass came at the end of the Third century A. D.

Navy Purchases

In 1943 the navy bought 22 million handkerchiefs, over 5.5 million blue and white undress jumpers, 1 million rubber overshoes, 11 million cotton undershirts, 10 million drawers, 4.3 million white trousers, 2.4 million white towels, 10 million black cotton socks, and 4 million chambray shirts.

Coras

With children around, safeguard your table lamps this way: Wrap lamp cords a couple of times around the table leg. This takes care of any loose hanging cords over which some one may trip.

Long Run

Couriers for the Turkish sultan during the middle ages often ran from Constantinople to Adrianople and back, a distance of about 220 miles, in two days and nights.

Scorch Marks

If cottons scorch when you're ironing them, plunge them immediately into cold water, leaving them there 24 hours. By that time, the marks should have disappeared.

New Insects

The 1944 interceptions of quarantine included some insects which never had been previously identified and were, therefore, potentially dangerous.

Brighten Pan

To brighten an aluminum pan, cook an acid such as tomatoes, tart apples or buttermilk in it.

Pie Crust

Try folding the top crust of a fruit pie over the lower crust before crimping to keep the juices in.

Save Juice

Avoid loss of juice in preparing meat, poultry and fish. Never soak such food in water.

Excellent Greens

Tiny young beets and tops cooked together make excellent greens.

Steaming Asparagus

Use an old percolator to steam asparagus and broccoli.

Bath Oil

Use a few drops of bath oil in the bath itself to soften the skin.

Decorate Wishbones

Save as many wishbones as you can from cooked chickens. Paint them gay colors and use one at a time, as decorative notes and added good wishes on gift packages.

Drying Vegetables

If you have a gas or electric range in your kitchen the oven offers a simple and satisfactory method to dry fruits and vegetables for winter meals.

Dust Corn

A 10 per cent DDT dust applied to the tips of ears after silks begin to dry will help prevent wormy roasting ears.
