Rural Traffic Deaths 3-1 Over City

Rural auto accidents kill three times as many Oregonians as do city accidents, it has been announced by Secretary of State Robert S. Farrell Jr.

Of the 480 traffic deaths in the state during the past year, three out of four occurred outside the limits of any city or town. Since by far the greatest bulk of auto mileages builds up inside cities, the risk over a given distance or time is vastly greater on non-city highways.

"The first month of this year points to an even higher percentage of rural deaths in 1947 than in 1946," Farrell said.

By "rural" is meant anyplace outside the confines of a town or city. Most of the rural deaths occur on the main highways, U. S. 97, 99, and 101 being the leaders. Speed is the biggest contributing factor.

"We are never going to solve this problem of danger on the open highway until the state builds adequate police patrol, Farrell said.

Prompt action in building up a rural traffic force is being urged since the problem is getting further out of hand almost daily. January gas consumption pointed to the state's piling up over 5,000,000 miles this year.

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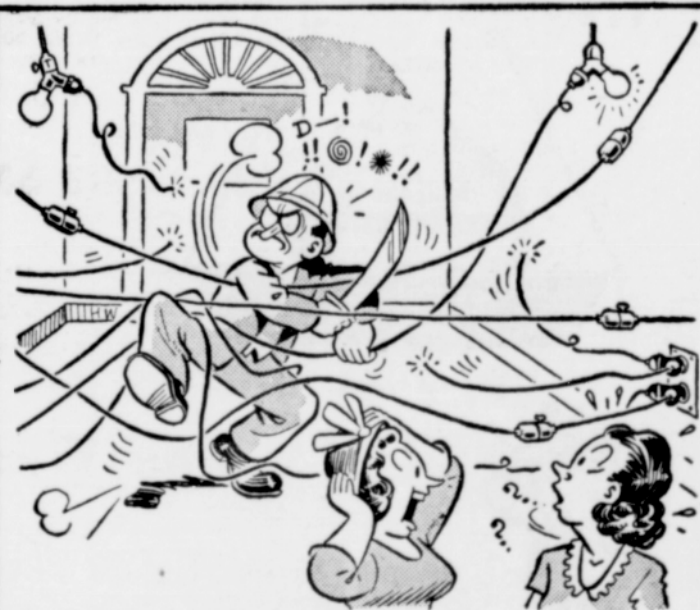
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
