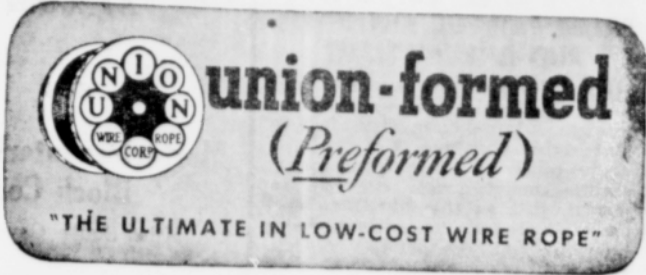

Coast Guard Wishes To Recruit 650 Men

The United States Coast Guard announces that it is anxious to recruit at least 650 men per month for the next five months. Young men with no previous military service between the ages of 17 and 25 are eligible for enlistment in a career which provides retirement after 20 years service, rapid advancement and security.

The Coast Guard is also interested in enlisting former petty officers of the Navy and Coast Guard who formerly held ratings as quartermaster, watertender, carpenter's mates, motor machinist mates, electrician mates, aviation electronics technician mates and ship's cooks. The age limit for these men is 17 to 35.

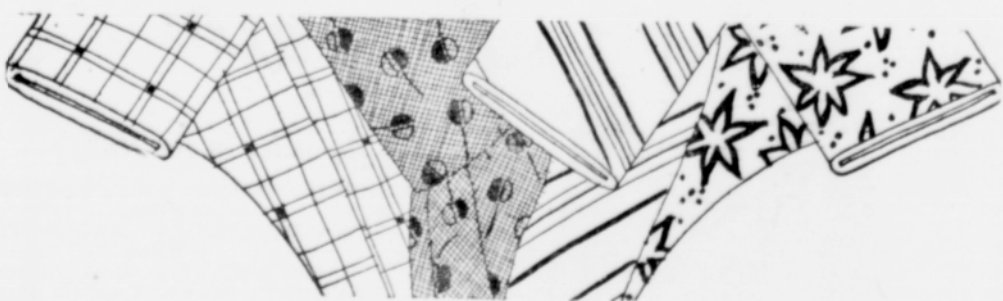
