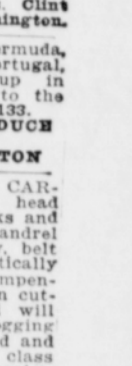
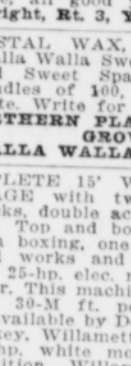
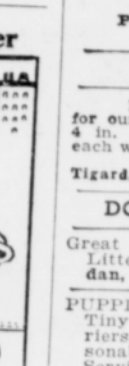
Greatest Fan Game

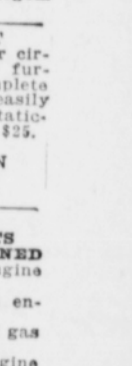
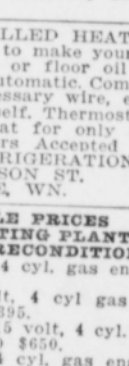
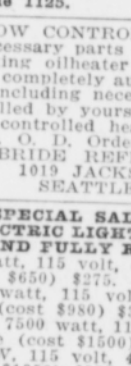
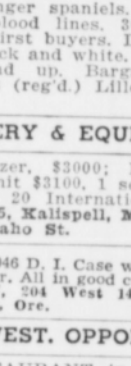
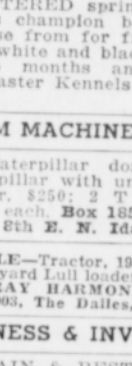
Became Private Property

The cordage industry produced about 200 million pounds of rope and twine last year. To ship this cordage by rail would require a freight train 500 miles long, with 66,666 cars.

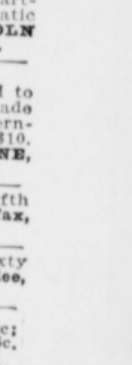
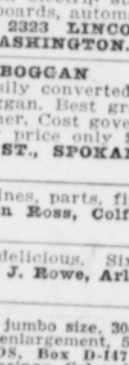
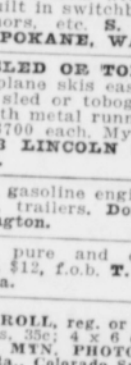
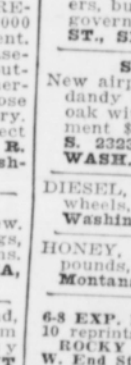
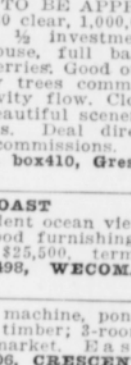
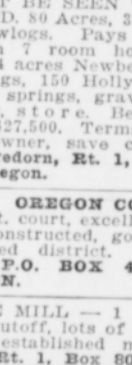
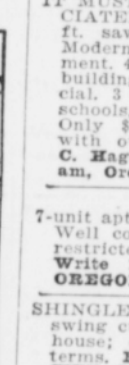
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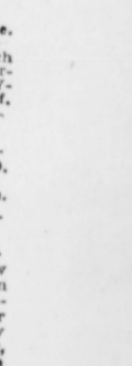
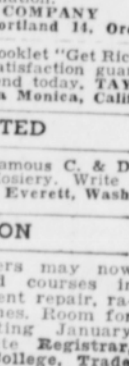
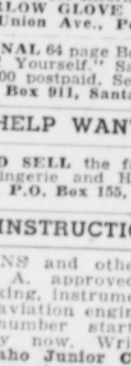
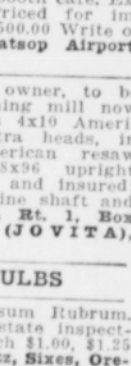
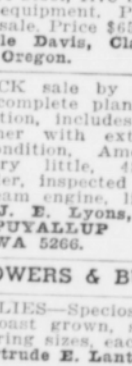
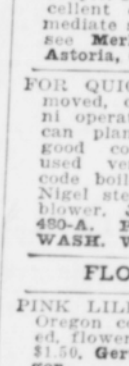
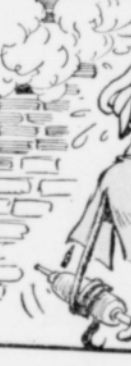
