Game Licenses Being Mailed by Commission

The 1948 game licenses are being mailed out by the Oregon State Game Commission to license agencies throughout the state. Deer tags, however, which will be issued separately for a fee of fifty cents to residents will not be available until after the first of July.

An entirely new form of license is being issued this year, made possible by the separation of the deer tag from the hunting license. License agents will be issued one form of license only, instead of eight kinds as heretofore, and will fill in on this form information as to type of license being issued, amount paid and name, address and description of purchaser. The new form of license is printed on safety paper in manifold form and is expected to save a considerable amount of time and money in the printing and handling of game licenses.

The separate deer tag is to be used for obtaining information essential to proper management of the deer herds, such as the total number of deer hunters, total kill, areas hunted most heavily, time

of heaviest kill and other factors.
