Former radiomen of the Navy and Coast Guard may now reenlist with the rating of radioman and receive full credit for former service toward retirement and for pay purposes.

In the cases of men with dependents, family allowance benefits are still in effect.

In addition to radiomen, the Coast Guard is also interested in enlisting a limited number of young men without previous military experience for assignment in this area.

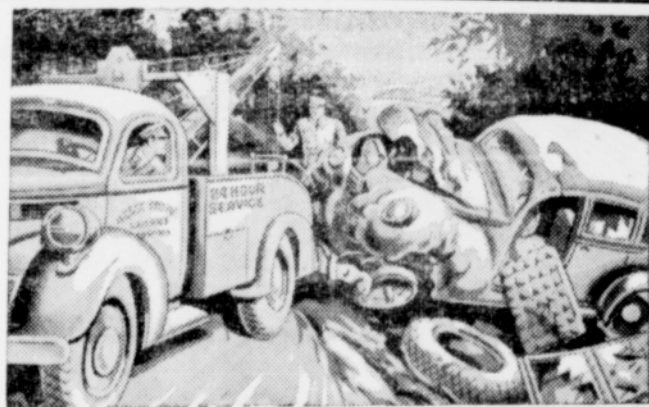
