Sealed bids will be received by the Forest Supervisor Grants Pass, Oregon, up to and not later than 2:00 p. m., April 13, 1948, for all the live timber marked or designated for cutting, and all merchantable dead timber located on an area embracing approximately 30 acres within Sec. 12, T. 39 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Siskiyou National Forest, Oregon, estimated to be 1,818,000 feet B. M., more or less of Douglas-fir, 72,000 feet B. M., more or less of Sugar Pine, and 12,000 feet B. M., more or less of White Fir and other species. No bid of less than \$10.00 per M feet for Douglas-fir, \$11.95 per M feet for Sugar Pine, and \$7.75 per M feet for White Fir and other species.

cies will be considered. In addition to the prices bid for stumpage a cooperative deposit of \$.35 per M feet B. M., to cover the cost of tree planting, seed sowing, and timber stand improvement work on the area cut over, for the total of timber under the terms of this agreement, will be required. \$1,500.00 must accompany each bid, to be applied on the purchase price, refunded, or retained in part as liquidated damages, according to the conditions of sale.

The right to reject any and all bids is reserved. Before bids are submitted, full information concerning the timber, the conditions of the sale, and the submission of bids should be obtained from the Forest Supervisor, Grants Pass, Oregon, or the District Ranger, Cave Junction, Oregon.

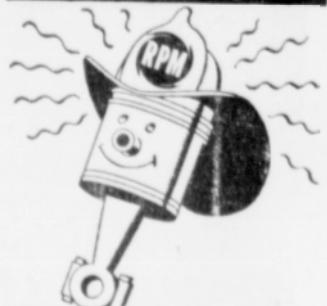
