to the Federal Power Commission.
Comments from all of these people
including the Governor, are re-
quested to be made within 90 days.

After the comments are received,
the report, together with the
comments, are sent to the Presi-
dent through the Bureau of the
Budget. After approval by the
Budget, it comes back to the Sec-
retary of the Interior and becomes
the Secretary's official report.

In the case of the Rogue River
report, it will be sent to Congress
with the recommendations of the
Secretary of the Interior. In Con-
gress, it will be referred to the
Public Lands Committee. A bill
may then be prepared and intro-
duced. After such a bill is intro-
duced in Congress, the committees
of both House and Senate will un-
doubtedly hold hearings on it,
where all matters in disagreement
may again be reviewed. If a bill

authorizing the construction of a
Rogue River project is passed by
Congress, no work can be started
until an appropriation is made by
Congress.

The procedure here outlined is

screening and investigation, and
is finally given an appropriation
for construction, it must be a good
and valuable project. It must be
a project that is economically
sound and of proven benefit.



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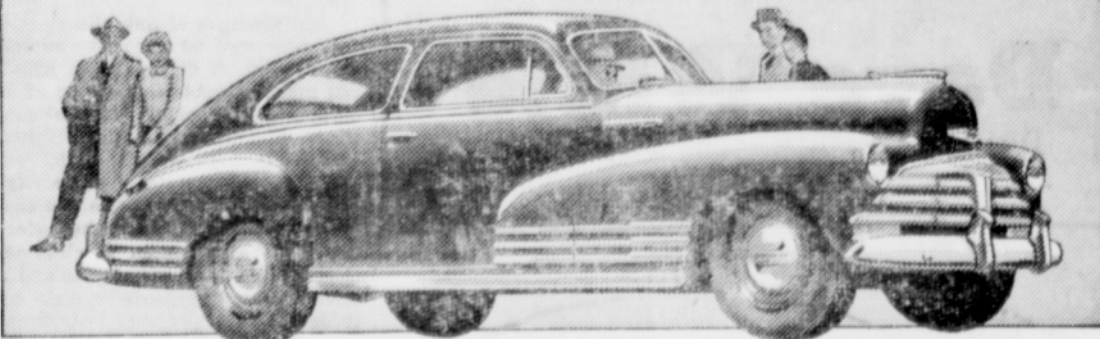
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
