NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,
that at the school district bond
election hereby called, to be held
in Josephine County, Oregon, in
and for the County School District
of Josephine County, Oregon, on
the 21st day of June, 1948, be-
tween the hours of 2 o'clock P. M.
and 7 o'clock P. M. there will be
submitted to the legal voters there-
of the question of contracting a
bonded indebtedness in the sum
of \$700,000.00, bearing not to
exceed legal interest per annum,
payable semi-annually, due and
payable in not to exceed 15 years
from date of issue, for the purpose
of providing funds with which to
acquire, construct, reconstruct,
improve, repair, equip and furnish
a school building or school build-
ings, or additions thereto, and to
acquire all property, real and
