

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE RED CROSS

The annual meeting of the Josephine county chapter, American Red Cross will be held on Tuesday, June 29th at 8 p.m. in the Circuit Court room of the County Courthouse. There will be a report of the activities of the chapter during the past year, and election of officers to serve from July 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949. The officers to be elected are chairman, vice-chairman, secretary and treasurer.

In addition 5 members will be elected to serve three years on the Board of Directors of the chapter. It is that all members of the Red Cross attend this meeting. Any person who has contributed \$1.00 or more to the Red Cross during the 1948 fund campaign is considered a member and is eligible to vote at the election.

The county chapter is accepting contributions to be used in the Disaster Relief headquarters for the Northwest Flood victims. There is very great need for contributions for this purpose.

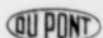
