SCHOOL DISTRICTS BOND ELECTION NOTICE

State of Oregon, County of
Josephine, County School District
of Josephine County, Oregon as.
NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN,
that at the school district bond
election hereby called, to be held
in Josephine County, Oregon, in
and for the County School District
of Josephine County, Oregon, on
the 17th day of July 1948, between
the hours of 2 o'clock p.m., Pa-
cific Standard Time, and 7 o'clock
p. m., Pacific Standard Time,
there will be submitted to the
legal voters thereof the
question of contracting a bonded
indebtedness in the sum of
\$700,000.00, bearing not to ex-
ceed legal interest per annum,
payable semi-annually, due and
payable in not to exceed 15 years
from date of issue, for the purpose
of providing funds with which to
acquire, construct, reconstruct,
improve, repair, equip and furnish
a school building or school build-
ings, or additions thereto, and to
acquire all property, real and
personal, appurtenant thereto or
connected therewith or for any
one or combination of two or more
of such purposes, in and for said
school district.

The vote to be by ballot upon
which shall be the words "Bonds .
.. Yes" and "Bonds . . . No.", and
the voter shall place a cross (X)
between the words "Bonds" and
the word "Yes" or between the
word "Bonds" and the word "No",
whichever indicates his choice.

The polls for the reception of
the ballots cast for or against the
contraction of said indebtedness
will, on said day and date and at
the places hereafter mentioned, be
opened at the hour of 2 o'clock
p. m., Pacific Standard Time, and
remain open until the hour of 7
o'clock p. m., Pacific Standard
Time, of the same day, at which
hour the same shall be closed.

The polling places for such
election will be the school houses
in the following sub-districts and
former sub-districts: Central,
Dimmick, Fort Vannoy, Galice,
Hugo, Jerome Prairie, Kerby High
School, Merlin, Murphy, New
Hope, Fruitdale, Oak Grove,
O'Brien, Selma, Sunny Valley,
Wilderville, Williams, Wolf Creek
and Provolt.

The former sub-districts of
Central and Provolt have been
abolished by reason of the discon-
tinuance of the elementary schools
in these two sub-districts. Polling
places will be provided in these
former sub-districts, however, for
the convenience of voters.
