SCHOOL DISTRICTS BOND ELECTION NOTICE

State of Oregon, County of Josephine, County School District of Josephine County, Oregon ss. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that at the school district bond election hereby called, to be held in Josephine County, Oregon, in and for the County School District of Josephine County, Oregon, on the 17th day of July 1948, between the hours of 2 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, and 7 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, there will be submitted to the legal voters thereof the question of contracting a bonded indebtedness in the sum of \$700,000.00, bearing not to exceed legal interest per annum, payable semi-annually, due and payable in not to exceed 15 years from date of issue, for the purpose of providing funds with which to acquire, construct, reconstruct, improve, repair, equip and furnish a school building or school buildings, or additions thereto, and to acquire all property, real and personal, appurtenant thereto or connected therewith or for any one or combination of two or more of such purposes, in and for said school district.

The vote to be by ballot upon which shall be the words "Bonds... Yes" and "Bonds... No", and the voter shall place a cross (X) between the words "Bonds" and the word "Yes" or between the word "Bonds" and the word "No", whichever indicates his choice.

The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the contraction of said indebtedness will, on said day and date and at the places hereafter mentioned, be opened at the hour of 2 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, and remain open until the hour of 7 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, of the same day, at which hour the same shall be closed.

The polling places for such election will be the school houses in the following sub-districts and former sub-districts: Central, Dimmick, Fort Vannoy, Galice, Hugo, Jerome Prairie, Kerby High School, Merlin, Murphy, New Hope, Fruitdale, Oak Grove, O'Brien, Selma, Sunny Valley, Wilderville, Williams, Wolf Creek and Provolt.

The former sub-districts of Central and Provolt have been abolished by reason of the discontinuance of the elementary schools in these two sub-districts. Polling places will be provided in these former sub-districts, however, for the convenience of voters.

PROCLAMATION: WHEREAS, the unregulated use of certain forest areas is, in the judgment of the State Forester, a menace to life and property due to conditions tending to cause or allow the rapid spread of fires which might occur or because of the inaccessible character of such areas due to the lack of suitable roads, and WHEREAS, upon the showing of the State Forester it appears to me to be necessary to close to unregulated use the following areas designated as:

AREA NO. R-1—All National Forests in Oregon and adjacent areas protected by the United States Forest Service as follows: Adjacent to Siskiyou National Forest: Sections 29 and 32, T. 31 S., R. 11 W.; Section 30, T. 32 S., R. 8 W.; T. 32 S., R. 9 W.; T. 33 S., R. 8 W.; T. 34 S., R. 8, 11 and 13 W.; T. 35 S., R. 8, 11 and 12 W.; T. 39 S., R. 12 W.; T. 41 S., R. 8 and 11 W.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Leslie W. Scott, Acting Governor of the State of Oregon, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of Section 107-210, Oregon Compiled Laws Annotated, as amended by Chapter 252, Oregon Laws, 1945, do hereby proclaim the unregulated use of the above described areas to be unlawful and do hereby close said areas and the same shall be subject to

use only upon condition that entrants shall comply with all of the following requirements or conditions: 1. To refrain from smoking while traveling in such areas. 2. To secure a permit issued by the forester or a fire warden before building a campfire other than at improved, designated and posted campground on such areas. 3. To have as a part of his or her equipment when using campfires, except when traveling as a pedestrian, and / or camping at improved, designated and posted campgrounds, tools as specified by the forester suitable for extinguishing fires. This proclamation shall be effective from and after the 1st day of July, 1948, and shall remain in full force and effect until and including the 31st day of December, 1948. Done at the Capitol in Salem, Oregon, this 29th day of June, 1948. /s/ Leslie W. Scott, Acting Governor; attest, Earl T. Newbry, Secretary of State.
