**Applicants for Drivers  
 License Muff Tests**  
 Almost half of the persons ap-  
 plying for their first Oregon  
 driver's license last month muffed  
 the written traffic law test on the  
 first try, Secretary of State Earl  
 T. Newbry has reported.  
 A brief study of the Oregon  
 driver's manual brought success  
 on the second attempt in most  
 cases, Newbry said, although the  
 second test asks different ques-  
 tions.  
 Drivers license division records  
 for May show 2208 would be hold-  
 ers of Oregon licenses needed a  
 second crack at the law test in ex-  
 aminations that resulted in 4545  
 new licenses issued during the  
 month. State examiners say this  
 is not an unusual percentage of  
 first-try failures.

 read their driver's manual first,"  
 Newbry said. "Those who read it  
 carefully have little trouble."  
 In addition to familiarity with  
 the more important traffic laws,  
 applicants for original licenses  
 are checked for adequate vision,  
 ability to identify traffic signs,  
 presence of essential equipment  
 on their cars, and are given short  
 road tests.  
 Driver's manual, issued free of  
 charge to applicants for learner's  
 permits, are pocket-sized illus-  
 trated booklets in which traffic  
 regulations and license require-  
 ments are listed in simplified form.  
 Most traffic accidents, Newbry  
 emphasized, are traceable in cause  
 to drivers or pedestrians "who  
 either did not know, or failed to  
 practice" the simple rules of good  
 driving and safe walking ex-  
 plained by the manual.




