GOV. DEWEY PROMISES FARM PRICE SUPPORT



Governor Thomas E. Dewey has announced to the nation's farmers that they can depend on continued price supports under a national Republican administration. Supports now in effect, he pointed out, were enacted by the Republican-controlled 80th Congress, establishing a policy which will serve as the farmer's best guarantee of similar legislation in the future. His statement, Governor Dewey said, was based on an agreement reached between himself and leaders of the Senate and House committees on agriculture, Senator George Aiken of Vermont (left) and Congressman Clifford Hope of Kansas (right).
