In the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for the County of Josephine.

PETERSON and JANE DOE PETERSON, his wife; MARY E. STANDARD and JOHN DOE STANDARD, her husband; ANNA M. WITTROCK, heir at law of John H. Wittrock, Deceased; OSCAR C. DIXON and JANE DOE DIXON, his wife; THOMAS HUTTON and JANE DOE HUTTON, his wife; JOSEPHINE COUNTY, a body politic incorporate of the State of Oregon, and the unknown heirs, if any, of the above named Defendants who might be deceased, and all other persons or parties unknown claiming any right, title, estate, lien or interest in the real property described in the Complaint, Defendants.

To each and all of the above named Defendants: In the Name of the State of Oregon, You, and each of you, are hereby required to appear in the above entitled Court and answer the Complaint filed against you in the above entitled suit on or before the last day of the four weeks from the date of the first publication of this Summons, and if you fail to so appear and answer the said Complaint, for want thereof, the Plaintiff will apply to the Court for the relief demanded in his Complaint, succinctly stated as follows, to-wit: That a decree be entered adjudicating any and all right, title, estate, lien or interest which you or any of you have or claim to have in, to or upon the real property situated in Josephine County, Oregon, described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the point of intersection of the center line of Seventh Street, of the town of Napoléon (now Kerby, Oregon) as of record and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Josephine County, Oregon, in Deed Records, Volume 2, Page 1, with the Westerly right of way line of the Redwood Highway, said point being approximately 401 feet South and 63 feet East of the North Quarter Corner of Section 9, in Township 39 South, Range 8 West, Willamette Meridian; thence running West 157 feet; thence North 150 feet to the Northeast Corner of Lot 7, Block 6 of said town; thence West 120 feet; thence South 150 feet to the center line of said Seventh Street; thence West, along said center line 330 feet to the center line of Oregon Street of said town; thence South along the center line of said Oregon Street 330 feet; thence West 531 feet to the West line of the James Kerby Claim No. 37; thence South 82 feet; thence West 145 feet to the West bank of an irrigation ditch, as now located; thence Southerly, along said ditch, the average course being South 14° 40' East 573 feet to the Southeast corner of Government Lot 1; thence East, along the South line of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 9, a distance of 588 feet, to a point which is 720 feet West of the Westerly right of way line of the Redwood Highway; thence North 16 feet; thence North 59° East 473.3 feet; thence East 290 feet, more or less, to the Westerly right of way line of the Redwood Highway; thence Northerly along said right of way line on an approximate 3 degree curve, the long chord bearing North 8° West 150 feet; thence East 10 feet; thence continuing along said right of way line on an approximate 3 degree curve, the long chord bearing North 14° 30' West 230 feet; and continuing on a tangent North 17° 11' West 344 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing 22.2 acres, more or less.
