### LEGAL NOTICES

#### ORDINANCE NO. 15

Authorizing and directing the Mayor and City Recorder of the City of Cave Junction, Oregon, to execute, sell and deliver Special Obligation Notes of said City in a sum not exceeding \$9,000.00, payable within a period of ten years, and bearing interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, said notes to be dated July 1, 1949, and be limited to the water revenues, present and future, as to the payment thereof, subject to certain priorities mentioned herein; authorizing the payment of the principal and interest on said notes from the Water Bond Sinking Fund; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City of Cave Junction has heretofore, and in 1949, issued Water Bonds in the aggregate sum of \$35,000.00 for the purpose of constructing and improving the municipal water system of said City; and

WHEREAS, the said system has now been virtually completed, but it is determined that approximately \$9,000.00 additional will be needed to defray the expense of said construction and improvement; and

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to devise a means of raising the additional amount needed by issuance of Special or Limited Obligation Notes of said City, payable solely from the revenue of the water department;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CAVE JUNCTION ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

#### Section 1

That the Mayor and City Recorder be and they are hereby authorized to execute, sell and deliver, at par only, and with no discount, Special Obligation Notes of the City of Cave Junction, Josephine County, Oregon, said notes to be in an aggregate sum of not exceeding Nine Thousand (\$9,000.00) Dollars, numbers 1 to 10, inclusive, to be in the denomination of \$500 each, and numbers 11 to 50, inclusive, to be in the denomination of \$100.00 each, said notes to bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum and to be payable one-fifth of the principal thereof on or before five years from July 1, 1949, and one-fifth of the principal thereof on or before July 1st of each year thereafter until the entire principal sum of said notes or obligations shall have been paid, said notes provide for interest on all unpaid balances at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest to be payable in legal tender of the United States of America at the office of the City Recorder of Cave Junction, Josephine County, Oregon, and to further provide that no payments may be made thereon except on January 1st or July 1st of each year, and said notes to provide that said obligations, both as to principal and interest, shall be payable by the City solely from the revenue of the water department thereof, and shall not constitute a general obligation of said City, and shall provide that the holder of said note or notes agrees to look to the water funds and revenues of the water department for payment, said notes to be in a form substantially as follows, to-wit:

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, the CITY OF CAVE JUNCTION, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, promises to pay to the holder hereof the sum of ..... DOLLARS, said sum to be payable at the times, in the amounts, and in manner as follows:  
\$..... or more on or before five years from the date hereof,

and \$..... or more on or before the first day of July each year thereafter, until the entire principal sum of this obligation shall have been paid, together with interest on all unpaid balances at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, both principal and interest payable in legal tender of the United States of America at the office of the City Recorder, in Cave Junction, Josephine County, Oregon. No payments may be made hereon except on January 1st or July 1st of each year.

This obligation, both as to principal and interest, shall be payable by said City solely from the revenues of the Water Department thereof, and shall not constitute a general obligation of said City, and the holder hereof agrees to look to the water funds and revenues of said Water Department for payment, which funds and revenues, both present and future, are fully pledged for the payment of this obligation in priority over any and all other purposes, except (a) maintenance of said department, and (b) payment of principal and interest on Water Bonds of said City outstanding.

This obligation is one of a series of Special Obligation Notes, totaling not to exceed \$9,000.00, given by said City, for the purpose of providing funds for the completion of the municipal water system.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the City of Cave Junction has caused this obligation to be signed by the Mayor, and countersigned by the Recorder, under the corporate seal of the City.

Section 2  
That all principal sums received from the sale of said notes shall be deposited in the "Water System Improvement Fund" and be used for the construction, improvement and completion of said water system. Any excess of said funds not required for such purpose shall be set aside to be applied on the payment of said Special Obligation Notes.

Section 3  
That the City Recorder shall prepare a record of the number and amount of each Special Obligation Note issued hereunder, and such record shall be adapted so as to show the current holder of the note and the interest payments made thereon.

Section 4  
That the legal expense incident to the issuance of said notes and the printing thereof shall be paid as a part of the construction of said water system.

Section 5  
For the payment of said Special Obligation Notes, all water department funds and revenues, both present and future, are fully pledged for the payment of said Special Obligation Notes in priority over any and all other purposes except (a) maintenance of said department, and (b) payment of principal and interest on Water Bonds of said City outstanding.

Section 6  
That notwithstanding the fact that said notes shall not constitute a general obligation of the City, nevertheless, in the event the budget shall permit the raising of funds by taxation, without exceeding the six per cent limitation, then such funds so raised may be applied to the payment of the principal and interest of said Special Obligation Notes.

Section 7  
Inasmuch as said additional funds are immediately required to make payment for the completion of said municipal water system, it is deemed necessary for the peace, health and safety of the citizens of Cave Junction that an emergency be and the same is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed at a regular meeting of the Common Council on the 11th day of July, 1949, the vote being as follows:
