State Bonus proponents at the American Legion convention just ended in Salem, pushed thru a resolution calling for a \$10 monthly payment for domestic duty and \$15 monthly for overseas duty to Oregon veterans of World War II.

A measure favoring an increase in per capita dues of 25c per member to sustain the vet's rehabilitation program was tabled by delegates following Past National Commander Frank Belgrano's charges of waste of Legion funds by national officers.

Sam M. Bowe, World War II veteran and attorney of Grants Pass, succeeds B. E. "Kelly" Owen of Salem, as State Commander. Clyde Dickey, Portland druggist and World War I vet, succeeded Bowe as department vice-commander. Grants Pass will be the scene of the next State convention in 1950.

DOMESTIC MINING THREATENED BY U. S. MINING POLICY

The U.S. mining industry is at long last learning the hard way that whatever threatens one branch threatens all, that any legislation depriving one member of his rights may be leveled against the rights of any member, or all.

When W.P.B. Suspension Order L-208, to no good purpose, on distorted statistics, illegally and with a suspicion of sinister intent of "certain economic forces", closed all U.S. gold mines, it would have been foresighted had the entire mining industry rushed to its defense. Because of that iniquitous W.P.B. Order, the short-sighted policy of reliance on foreign mineral production was inaugurated, with gold as the guinea pig. With the same callous disregard of the welfare of U.S. mining, and those directly and indirectly interested in and dependent on it, the same policy of reliance on foreign mineral production is now being applied to copper, lead and zinc.

With a great fanfare of good neighborliness and generous sharing of our "knowhow" to backward peoples, coupled with the snide suggestion by further distorted statistics, this time of the official "have notters", that U.S. minerals are on the verge of exhaustion, the Administration is again getting away with murder. Already our bureaucratic group of world planners is spending your tax dollars to send geologists and mining engineers abroad to explore foreign mineral resources. With more of your tax dollars these super intellectuals are subsidizing the cost of developing their findings, and are approving tariff reductions so as to cheaply import the production of these foreign deposits.

The results of this policy of relying on foreign mineral production, that spells ruin to U.S. mining, are various and wide spread. The loss to our citizens who have backed our miners and our mining industry is obvious. More critical though, is the loss in livelihood to thousands engaged in mining throughout our western states, the loss of their communities, and the loss to every business that serves their needs.

If this scheme of by-passing U.S. mineral resources in favour of those abroad that have the benefit of low taxes, underprivileged labor and the dupious advantage of shyster deals backed by the authority, capital and military strength of our Government, is to be accepted, it will bring a cessation to all U.S. mining and abandonment of the development and expansion of our natural mineral resources. It will mean an end of the basic revenue of our West. Under this blighting policy, our West will take the place of those foreign lands in which the Administration shows such tender concern, and will decline to the status of an abandoned colony.

To oppose this short-sighted and ruinous policy, the mining interest of our western states must assemble and determine on united action for the protection of our citizens engaged in working and serving U. S. mining, and for the progressive development of our own vast mineral resources.
