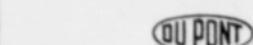

VETS ORGANIZATIONS GET 33 1/2 THOUSAND

Three service organizations—the American Legion, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Disabled American Veterans—are eligible for receipt of state funds authorized by the 1949 legislature to help such groups pay the cost of rehabilitation services to veterans.

Regulations just approved by the committee provide that only those organizations which have maintained department service offices during the past two years in the Portland regional office of the Veterans Administration to present compensation, pension and other claims before the VA are qualified to receive funds under the new state law, chapter 364, Oregon Laws 1949.

Funds available in the Department of Veterans' Affairs budget for the biennium to pay the organizations amount to \$33,529.

DRINKING A FACTOR IN TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS

Driver violations and drinking continued to lead all other factors in causing Oregon traffic accidents during the first six months of this year, Secretary of State Earl T. Newberry reported today.

A recently-completed survey of all motor vehicle accidents taking place from January through June revealed 54 percent involved a violation of a traffic law or drinking on the part of at least one of the drivers concerned, Newberry said. These two factors figured in 65 percent of Oregon's fatal accidents for that period.

The summary, to be distributed soon, is compiled from reports submitted by drivers involved in all accidents in which any property was damaged, in compliance with the state accident reporting law.

Total accidents numbered 29,400 as against 31,002 in the first six months of last year. There were 589 fewer automobile-inflicted injuries and 65 fewer fatalities, a death reduction of 34 percent.
