

Oregon 4-H'ers Win Chicago Trips

SUPERIOR records of achievement in National 4-H Clothing, Field Crops, Girls' Record and Poultry programs have won 1949 state championship honors for 4 Oregon club members. Each received an all-expense trip to the 28th National 4-H Club Congress, Chicago, Nov. 27 to Dec. 1. The winners, who were selected by the state club office, and brief outlines of their records follow:

State winner in the 1949 National 4-H Field Crops program was Kenneth Hill, 17, of Cove. He was given an all-expense trip to the National 4-H Club Congress, Chicago, by International Harvester Co., sponsor of the program. What Kenneth learned about soil preparation, seed treatment and new methods of cultivation enabled him to make an outstanding record. He has farmed 77 acres of crops and kept records of soil conservation practices on 280 acres. His crops projects made it possible for him to feed his livestock more economically. The 4-H Club program not only has helped Kenneth and his club members, but the community and county as a whole. Emphasis has been put on soil conservation, a greatly increased acreage of certified seed crops, and better livestock breeding. A 4-H'er for four years, Kenneth held several offices in his local club. He also has participated in 32 exhibits and demonstrations, winning many awards.

A fitting climax in the National 4-H Clothing Achievement program is to be chosen State winner. The 1949 honor went to Mary Rust, 18, of Azalea. Her record indicates that she made, altered or mended many of her own clothes and some for others. She has made 17 clothing exhibits, winning many high awards, including \$92.90 in cash prizes. Rounding out a successful club career, Mary served her local club in many offices and is their leader. In recognition of Mary's good work, Spool Cotton Co., Educational Bureau, provided the award of an all-expense trip to National 4-H Club Congress.

Sixteen projects in seven years of 4-H work is a record worth crowing about. And that's just

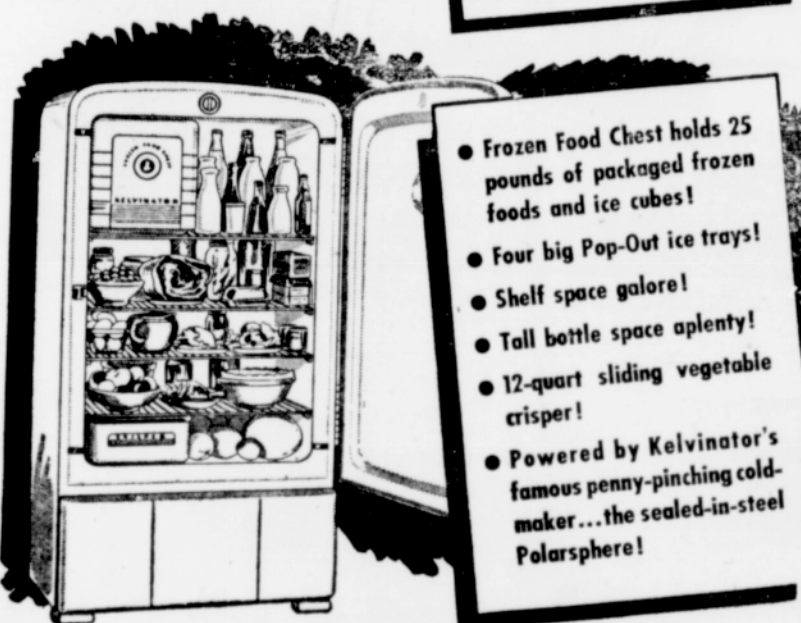
what Don Phillips, 17, of Grants Pass is doing because he won State honors in the 1949 National 4-H Poultry Achievement program. Altogether Don tended 885 chickens and his experience as poultry judge brought many honors, including first place at state fair. Knowledge and skill acquired in this project enabled him to build up a poultry business that has grossed \$4,254. He has learned to combat disease from which his chickens suffered, and also how to run his poultry project economically. Even though many hours of hard work went into this program, Don took part in 20 judging contests, served as club president five years, and as junior leader one year. He is an excellent public speaker and gave 63 talks on 4-H, ten of them over the radio. Don's reward was an all-expense trip to the National 4-H Club Congress in Chicago, provided by Dearborn Motors Corp., awards donor for the program.

To be named state winner in the National 4-H Girls' Record program means that the young lady is most proficient in not only one homemaking project, but in several. This honor went to Patricia Horning, 19, of Sherwood, who completed five years in 4-H Club work. She canned 144 quarts of food, 153 jars of jellies and jam; made, mended, or remodeled 73 garments; served 67 meals; prepared 114 separate dishes and made 111 bakings. Patricia has held many offices in her club and the county, and is leader of her local club. She has won many awards on her exhibits, including \$260.94 in cash prizes. In recognition of her achievements, Patricia attended the National 4-H Club Congress in Chicago as a guest of Montgomery Ward.
