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National Service Life Insurance Refunds

All refund checks on National Service Life insurance for World War II veterans were expected to be distributed by June 30.

Any veteran who has not received his check should contact the County Service officer in Grants Pass, bringing his return card if one has been received. Otherwise he should bring his discharge and insurance number if possible. The claim can then be investigated and the reason for the delay determined.
