Navy Will Issue Orders To Reserve Volunteers As Billets Are Available

The Navy department has advised the Commandant Thirteenth Naval District that it will issue orders to those uaval reserve officers who have volunteered their services as billets become available.

Due to the work load incident to processing such voluntary requests for return to active duty, the department is unable to acknowledge receipt of the requests; nor can it answer inquiries as to the status of each application or the availability of billets.

"Orders will be issued in accordance with the needs of the service and with the individual officers qualifications," the navy department stated.

In each instance, the announcement said, provision will be made for a delay of ten days from the time of receipt or orders to the date of reporting.
