Civil Service Exams For Farm Credit Examiner

The United States Civil Service Commission today announced examinations for Farm Credit Examiner to fill positions paying \$3,825 to \$5,400 a year in the Farm Credit Administration of the Department of Agriculture located throughout the United States, and for Photographer positions in various agencies in Washington, D. C., and vicinity with salaries ranging from \$2,650 to \$3,825 a year.

Persons appointed to Farm Credit Examiner positions are usually assigned work which may require travel over the entire United States. To qualify, applicants must have had at least 3 years of responsible general experience in accounting or auditing of the public or commercial type, or in the field of finance which involves the extension of agricultural credit. From 1 to 3 years of specialized experience of the public accounting type which included the audit of financial institutions is also required. Accounting education or the teaching of accounting may be substituted for general experience. Applicants may also substitute for the general experience the possession of a certificate as a credited public accountant. No written test is required.

The Photographer examination covers the options of Still, Motion Pictures, and Process. To qualify, applicants must pass a written test, and, in addition, have had from 1 to 4 years of experience in photographic work. Courses in photography may be substituted for as much as 2 years of experience.

Further information and application forms may be secured at most first and second-class post offices, from civil-service regional offices, or from the U.S. Civil Service Commission, Washington 25, D.C. Applications for both of these examinations must be filed with the Commission's office in Washington, D. C. The closing date for Farm Credit Examiner is August 15, 1950, and for Photographer, August 22, 1950.
