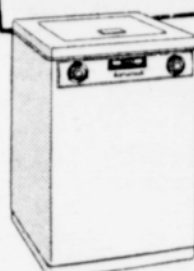

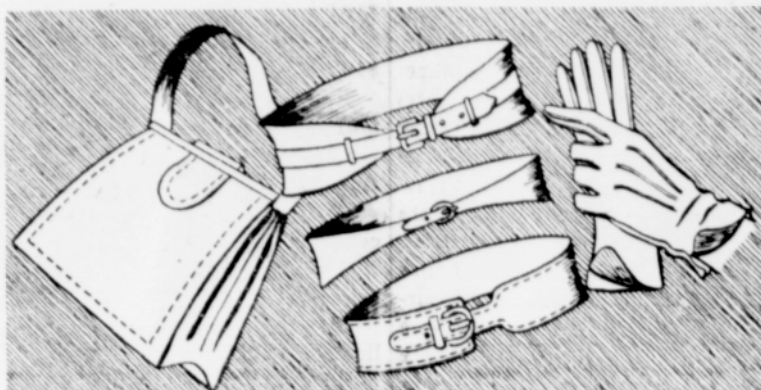

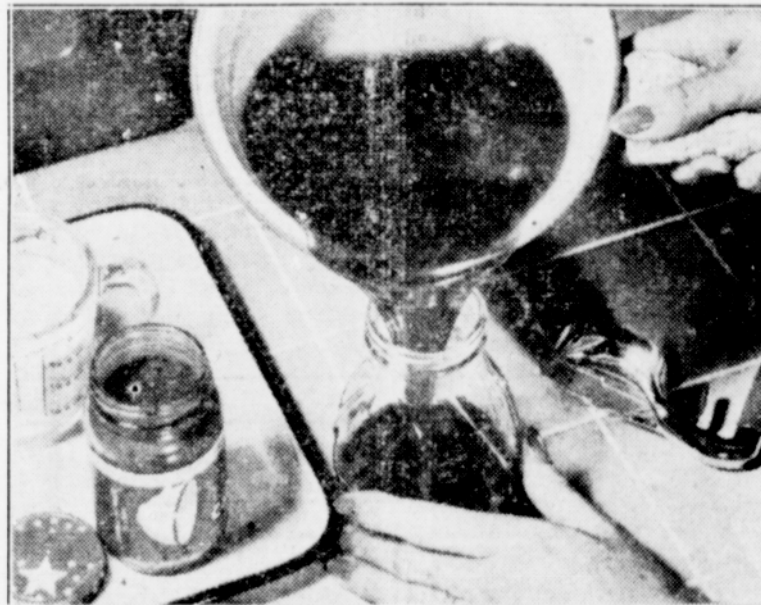

SATURDAY —

How five men and a girl make their way across the sun-baked, wind-swept Mojave desert, braving the elements and battling the vengeance of an outlaw mob, forms the background basis for "Along the Great Divide."

Kirk Douglas, in his first outdoor role, essays the part of a U. S. marshal forced to escort his prisoners through the blazing sands rather than turn them over to a lynch-hungry band of cattlemen.

On the distaff side, lovely Virginia Mayo is seen as the girl who must choose between love for her father and the man sworn to bring him to justice. It is this conflict which brings about the suspenseful climax of the new drama.

SUNDAY and MONDAY —

Surging from the pages of the celebrated C. S. Forester novel, "Captain Horatio Hornblower" turns to the screen in Warner Bros. Technicolor sea saga.

All the color of the times, the English, Spanish and French men-of-war, the battles of their respective fleets, the intrigues and power diplomacy of the nations during the Napoleonic era are in this screen drama.

Not the least of all is the great love story — the romance which takes place between Captain Hornblower and Lady Barbara, sister of the Duke of Wellington.

Among some of the most exciting of Hornblower's heroic exploits seen are a raid on the stronghold of a Spanish pirate, the blockade and storming of Napoleon's navy, a daring escape under the shadow of the guillotine and the commandeering of a prison ship by a handful of men.

WEDNESDAY and THURSDAY —

The dramatic story of a fighting editor, highlighted by a tense mine disaster and a moving romance, is brought to the screen in "Home Town Story," starring Jeffrey Lynn, Donald Crisp and Marjorie Reynolds.

Jeffrey Lynn gives an incisive, biting performance as the stubborn, egotistical editor who faces life with a chip on his shoulder. The veteran Donald Crisp makes a discerning and persuasive portrayal of the successful industrialist, and Marjorie Reynolds is excellent as the attractive school teacher who tries to humanize the man she loves.

There are also a number of fine supporting performances, among them that of Marilyn Monroe as a flip and knowing secretary, Alan Hale Jr. as a two-fisted reporter, Barbara Brown as the sympathetic Mrs. Washburn, and nine-year old Melinda Plowman, as little Katie, the tot trapped in the mine cave-in.

Tension and suspense are woven deep into the fabric of "Where Danger Lives," dramatic vehicle for Robert Mitchum, Faith Domergue and Claude Rains.

Miss Domergue, for her long-awaited debut in this striking film, plays a beautiful psychopath who charms a young doctor into becoming a willing victim of her unbalanced ambitions. It is a difficult role to make convincing, but she does it brilliantly. Mitchum, as the doctor, and Rains, as her luckless husband, also deliver splendid portrayals, and the excellent supporting cast is featured with Maureen O'Sullivan and Charles Kemper.

Married to an elderly millionaire whom she detests, Miss Domergue sees in the doctor a solution to her problems. Keeping the fact of her marriage a secret, she maneuvers the infatuated medical man into a violent quarrel with her husband, convinces the doctor that he has committed a murder and sets off with him on a wild flight to Mexico.

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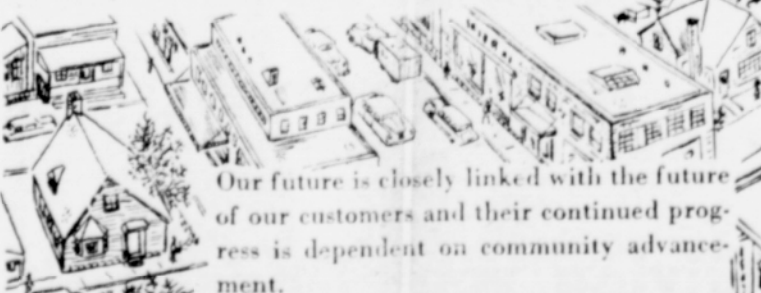
