SHOW REVUE

FRIDAY and SATURDAY —

"Passage West" is a strikingly fresh adventure drama that packs a real entertainment punch. The film recounts the terror-ridden journey of a group of pioneers held captive by a band of escaped convicts.

Starring John Payne, beautiful Arleen Whelan and Dennis O'Keefe, the picture starts out with the stinging impact of a whiplash, and sustains the excitement and suspense as the wagon trail train rolls desecrately to a raw frontier.

As the brutal convicts who ruthlessly commands the wagon train, John Payne is authoritative and credible in a difficult part. Dennis O'Keefe is equally effective as the preacher who is forced to resort to his fists when faith and restraint fail, while Arleen Whelan brings beauty and spirit to the role of the girl who must choose between a killer and a minister.

SUNDAY and MONDAY —

The stirring, excitement pitched and deeply moving story of the heroes of the valiant 442nd Regimental Combat Team, most decorated unit of World War II, is brought to the screen in "Go For Broke!" a picture which for dramatic power, emotional tautness and human appeal has not been equaled since the fides-succesful "Battleground."

Van Johnson, who was so good as the humorous G. I. in "Battleground" is even more compelling and persuasive as the tough officer who makes almost a religion of discipline in "Go For Broke!" While most of his scenes are played with the 442nd men, he is given a brief respite in a romantic interlude in a Tuscan village, where he meets the flirtatious Rosina, delightfully played by the Italian newcomer, Gianna Canale. The men enacting the heroes of the 442nd Regimental Combat Team are actual veterans of the famed unit and prove themselves as much at home in front of the cameras as they were on the battle lines. They are all deserving of applause, from Lane Nakano, playing the thoughtful Sam, down to Henry Nakamura, as the diminutive Tommy, who, together with a pig he has adopted as company mascot, steals many of the laughs.

WEDNESDAY and THURSDAY —

"The Big Carnival" is a sometimes shocking, frequently surprising and always exciting film drama that carries more impact, power and sheer entertainment than has sparked a picture in a long, long time. Starring Kirk Douglas as a memorable three-dimensional heel, and with Jan Sterling supplying a sizzling characterization as a blonde fire hazard, the film socks out the story of a disgraced reporter fighting his way back to the big time.

Douglas' performance as the unscrupulous reporter who gambles with a man's life to save his own career is a gem—powerful, controlled and thoroughly believable. Jan Sterling's faithless wife is frighteningly real and a characterization that establishes her as one of the screen's most capable performers. Bob Arthur, Porter Hall and Frank Cady also supply finely drawn portrayals that lend depth to a superior screen drama.

AND

The picturesque Southwest Territory of the 70's forms the setting for the exciting adventures star Tim Holt and his Irish-Mexican saddle pal, Chito Rafferty, experience in their latest picture "Border Treasure."

A band of outlaws plans to steal a rich load of treasure which has been contributed to the relief of victims of a disastrous earthquake in Mexico. Through the efforts of Tim and Chito, the bandits are frustrated, the treasure is recovered and conveyed safely to the border.

Holt as usual is excellent as the straight-shooting, hard-riding cowboy who adds to the suspense of the picture with his feats of reckless daring. Richard Martin also is his dependable self as the inimitable Chito. Others in the cast include Jane Nigh, John Doucette, House Peters Jr., and Inez Cooper.
