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SHOW REVUE

FRIDAY and SATURDAY —

The career and extra-curricular romantic activities of an airline stewardess form the novel and engaging subject of the film "Three Guys Named Mike."

Jane Wyman is cast as the picture's appealing heroine, with the three guys named Mike played respectively by Van Johnson as a shy graduate research student in chemistry, Howard Keel as a virile American Airlines pilot, and Barry Sullivan as a suave advertising executive.

SUNDAY and MONDAY —

"Take Care of My Little Girl" propels onto the screen for the first time the snobbishness of college sorority life. Told against an entertaining college background with a cast peopled by attractive young folk, and photographed in Technicolor, the film reveals the controversial aspects of the sorority issue without assuming the pattern of a "problem" picture.

Essentially, the new film, which stars Jeanne Crain, is designed to capitalize on the freshness of its theme while emphasizing the youth and brightness of colorful campus life.

WEDNESDAY and THURSDAY —

Monty Woolley with his flowing white beard dyed black for the first time, ably aided by his co-stars Thelma Ritter, David Wayne and Jean Peters romp through a highly entertaining comedy in "As Young As You Feel."

From the opening scene where the bewhiskered star shows his virtuosity on the piccolo to the final fade-out, this picture generates continuous laughter. After watching Thelma Ritter as Woolley's daughter-in-law, who forsakes a career as a vaudeville singer to take over the duties of his household, it is easy to understand why she has been elevated to the rank of star in her short Hollywood career.

"Sealed Cargo," the second feature on this bill, brings Dana Andrews, Carla Balenda and Claude Rains in the starring roles.
