Entries closed late last Wednesday evening and McClure said they had topped previous years' figures.

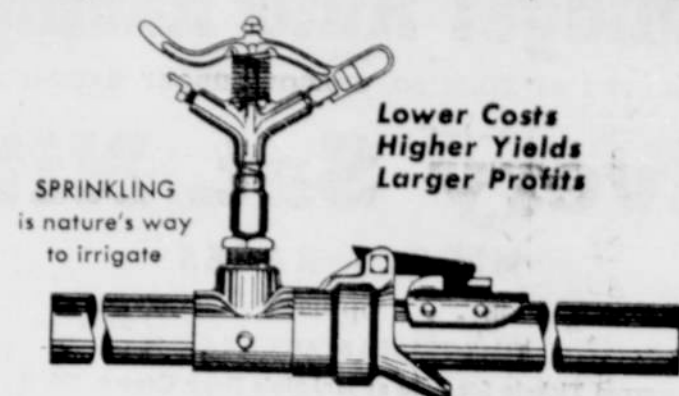

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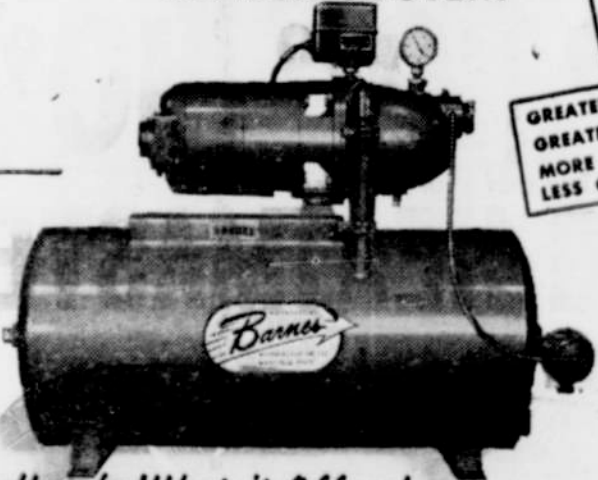
