**Beetle Infested Fir To Be Sold Dec. 10**

Forest service Douglas Fir damaged by the bark beetle on Broken Kettle Creek will be sold to the highest bidder at a sale at the Illinois Valley Ranger station Dec. 10 at 2 p.m.

The infested trees will be logged this winter to prevent the spread of adult beetles to other trees.

The marked trees amount to approximately 120,000 board feet and will be scaled. The successful bidder will be required to make full payment at the time the sale is awarded. The appraised stumpage price is \$10.
