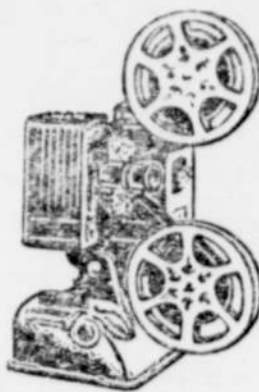
J. L. Jameson directed his grade school band in a few numbers. Refreshments were served in the cafeteria.
