Sunday School Rally

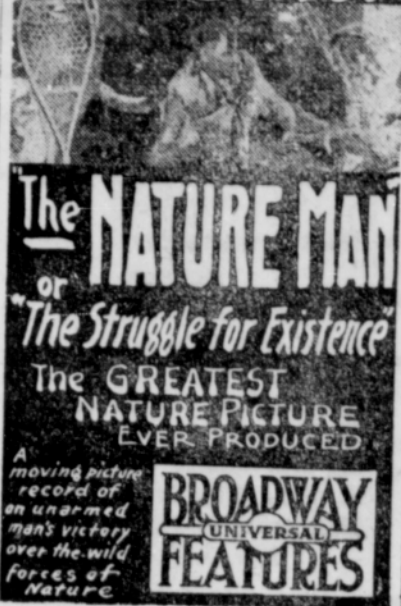
