A Good Good Roads Bill

There is pending before the state legislature at this time a road bill which calls for a \$10,000,000 road bond issue, the sale of which bonds is to be extended over a period of five years and the money is to be used in constructing hard surface highways. The matter of using this money and selling these bonds is to be left entirely with the state highway commission and they are to build the roads where they think they are most needed.

Our representative, D. C. Thoms, is a member of the road and highway committee in the legislature and he assures us that there will be no tax levied on real estate or chattels to pay for the bonds, but that the money will come from an increase in the auto license and from a 1 cent per gallon tax to be placed on gasoline and distillate. It is figured out and shown that enough money will be raised in this way to pay off the bonds and the interest during the next five years.
