Our Sermonette.

Ye therefore, beloved, seeing ye know these things before, beware lest ye also, being led away with the error of the wicked, fall from your steadfastness. But grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 3: 17, 18.

We grow in knowledge as we take note of the promises of God and by faith apply them to ourselves, and seek to discern in our lives the fulfillment of those promises; we grow in grace simultaneously, for unless each item of knowledge be received into a good and honest heart, and bring forth its measure of obedience and righteousness (grace), we will not be prepared for the next step of knowledge, and would thus be stopped, or possibly turned back. The primary purpose of the meet is to promote a spirit of friendly rivalry between the schools and to build up a desire among the students to keep them selves more "fit" physically. We understand the Halsey school was not represented last year in this meet. Whatever good is going, Halsey should get its share of it. Any pupils from Halsey who wish to compete are welcome in whatever class they belong.

Salvation Army To Operate A Home And Industrial School.

With enthusiasm unparalleled in the history of social service in Oregon, members of the recently formed county advisory boards of the Salvation Army Home Service Plan for 1920, in convention at the Hotel Portland last week, not only adopted a budget of \$224,000 asked for by the state advisory board, but increas-

ed this budget to approximately \$284,300.

The increase was made to include in the 1920 program the purchase of the Bishop Scott school and 100 acres on farm near Yamhill in Yamhill county for a Salvation Army Industrial Home and Agricultural school in which to educate and build up juvenile dependants and orphans.

The budget includes items of purchase or construction of buildings and the expansion of the Salvation Army field work so that the smallest community in the state will be served.

The budget was asked in the report which was a condensation of the findings of the state advisory board after a study of the confidential reports of the county boards detailing conditions in their counties. It is the first complete study of the state of Oregon with the end in view of tabulating its needs for a direct service to take care of indigents, and orphans, as well as to serve the friendless, homeless and suffering.

Following the presentation of the report by Secretary Henry E

Reed of the state board, its adoption was moved by J M Hawkins, chairman of the Linn county board, who prefaced his motion by a story of the work the Salvation Army was now doing in his district. The motion was seconded by Dr B F Pound of Salem, and passed unanimously.

Adjournment to luncheon was followed by a program of addresses during which, Judge Geo Stapleton, vice chairman of the state board, told of the need of a school in Oregon to care for its dependent juveniles.

It was announced that the Salvation Army had had offered to it for such a purpose the Bishop Scott home at a very moderate price.

Ex Senator F J Miller of Albany, arose and led a spontaneous movement which swept the convention off its feet and which led to a motion made by Judge Stapleton and seconded by Dr Pound, being placed before the convention for a vote. The motion asked for an increase of approximately \$40,000 in the budget to cover the expense of purchasing and reopening the home as a state-wide institution under

Salvation Army jurisdiction. The motion carried with a roar of ayes and applause.

The convention turned the financial phase of the campaign over to John L Ethridge, who as director general will build up an organization throughout the state. The financial program will receive the backing and support of advisory boards in every county of the state.

It was announced at the convention that the budget would be divided between Portland and the state outside of Portland so that half will be raised in the metropolis and half in the country. The quotas will be announced later.
