Miss Lucy Harker Goes To Her Rest.

The funeral services were held from the Christian church on Sunday last for Lucy D Harker, who passed away at 3:30, Friday morning, June 5, 1920, after an illness culminating in pneumonia.

The church was filled with the many citizens desirous of paying their last respects, and a splendid service was conducted by Elder C H Phillips, the pastor. Appropriate hymns were sung by a quartet consisting of Mrs E Robnett, Mrs A Robnett, and Messrs Isom and Poole.

Elder Phillips delivered a sermon on "Death," desiring to impress upon all the great truth that is a part of the great providence of God and that in Christ it loses all of its horrors and becomes, in the light of Scripture language, a departure, a sleep, and a rest. He spoke feelingly of the deceased having had but little joy in this world because of her many sufferings, but of the assurance of her joy being made full in heaven because of her faith and trust in her Savior.

Lucy Harker was the second child of Seby and Hannah Harker, well respected residents of Halsey for many years. She was born in Peoria county Illinois, August 19, 1858, coming west with her parents in 1891.

She was a member of the Christian church at her death and resided with her sister, Mrs W F White of Halsey. Mrs W F White and Mrs Clara Cross of Halsey, and Mrs G T Ray of Eugene, are her sole surviving relatives.
