Salvation Army Leaders Consider Postponing Drive.

At a conference of the local Salvation Army campaign committee with representatives of the state organization held lately, the postponement of the Linn county drive until some more opportune time was discussed; and unless the campaign develops more support and interest, such action will be taken within a short time, according to the announcement of those who participated.

"If Linn county does not raise its quota, there is a possibility that the purchase of the Bishop Scott school at Yamhill as a boys' and girls' farm school, a movement which originated in Linn county, will have to be given up," said Commandant R C Oldenburg of Seattle.

Hon F J Miller, of Albany, is the person who originated the idea to buy the Yamhill property. At a recent convention of Salvation Army workers at Portland he pointed out the great good that could be accomplished and after his speech Judge Stapleton made the motion to make the purchase. This was unanimously carried and accordingly the state organization of the Salvation Army took steps to secure it. It has apportioned the sum of \$40,000 with which to make the purchase, the funds for which were to be obtained in the present drive.

Mr Miller was present at the conference and after it was over he said:

"I feel keenly the apathy that seems to exist in Linn county as to the Salvation Army campaign. The Yamhill property is admirably adapted to just such a use as the Salvation Army is planning to make of it. At this time especially, there is great need for such an institution in the state for orphaned boys and girls particularly, many of whom, if left to themselves stray from the paths of right."

The statement was made following the meeting that about 80 per cent of the state's quota has been raised. Linn county has barely reached 25 per cent of its apportionment.

Fair Officials Visit Lebanon to Determine Quota.

F H Pfeiffer, chairman, and A C Schmitt, secretary, respectively of the Linn County Fair Association, went to Lebanon last Friday evening, where they met with the citizens of that city for the purpose of arranging the quota of stock to be subscribed by its citizens.

The meeting was a harmonious one in every way and Lebanon citizens in their action showed a determination to give the fair its most earnest support.

Republican County committee Organized

Last Thursday afternoon the Republican county committee met at Albany and organized for the coming two years.

D H Bodine of Albany, was selected for permanent chairman, Miss Lelia Mitchell of Albany, permanent secretary, and D Taylor of Halsey permanent treasurer.

Atty W L Marks of Albany, was elected member for Linn county of the state republican central committee, and Rex W Davis of Harrisburg, member of the congressional republican committee.

On that executive committee of fourteen members we notice the names of W D Porter of Shedd, Mrs Kate Porter of Halsey, and Mrs Etta Sawyer of Brownsville.

Democratic Central Committee Elects officers

Members of the Linn county democratic central committee met at the court house last Thursday afternoon and organized to carry on the work of the party.

D S Smith was elected chairman, C C Bryant secretary and treasurer and A K McMahon, state committeeman.

On the executive committee we noticed the names of A A Tussing of Brownsville, S M Garland of Lebanon, and C J Shedd of Shedd, and W L Wright of Harrisburg.

Harding & Coolidge.

Last Saturday evening the republican convention on the tenth ballot nominated Senator Harding of Ohio, for president, and Governor Coolidge of Massachusetts, for vice president.

Warren G Harding, of Marion, Ohio, was born in Blooming Grove, Morrow county, Ohio, November 2, 1865; he has been a newspaper publisher since 1884; is married; was a member of the 75th and 76th Ohio general assemblies as senator from the thirteenth district, 1889 to 1903, and Lieutenant governor of Ohio in 1904 and 1905; elected to the United States Senate November 3, 1914. His term of service will expire March 3, 1921.

It shows Senator Harding to be a modest man. He is what former Governor Frank B Willis of Ohio, described him to be in his nominating speech: "In personal character he has the dignity, urbanity and breadth of vision of McKinley. Like that other great Ohioan, he is one of the common folks' best loved fighting republicans, who believes in the efficiency of representative government under party sponsorship. That modest, dignified, substantial citizen; that aggressive, sane, cool headed leader of men; that typical American."

The republicans hope to march to victory with this modest Ohio editor and Governor Calvin L Coolidge as the standard bearers of their party.
