Commission Fixes Route of Pacific Highway.

Tuesday afternoon at Portland the state highway commission officially adopted the route of the Pacific highway from Albany to the Willamette river at Harrisburg.

The route follows the county road south from Albany as far as Driver's crossing, whence it angles to the Calapooia river, which it crosses alongside of the Southern Pacific railroad bridge.

After crossing the river the route turns to the right until it meets the county road into Shedd.

The route as accepted practically co-incides with the survey made. It parallels the R R from Shedd to Harrisburg, thereby eliminating railroad crossings.

The formal decision of the board means that a bridge will be erected by the state and Linn and Lane counties at Harrisburg within the near future.
