Grange Backs American Plan.

The National Grange adopted a resolution at its recent convention in Boston declaring for the open shop and in fayor of collective bargaining.

"We disapprove of any system," the resolution said, "which denies to any individual the right to work in any place where there is need of his industry at any time and at any wage which is satisfactory to him, or quit his employment wherever and for whatever reason may be to him controlling, subject only to such contract obligations as he may willingly enter into and as may be imposed in an American court of justice."

The grange is against labor radcalism which would throttle inlustry and limit production by enforcement of closed shop rules which deny employment to large numbers of competent workmen.
