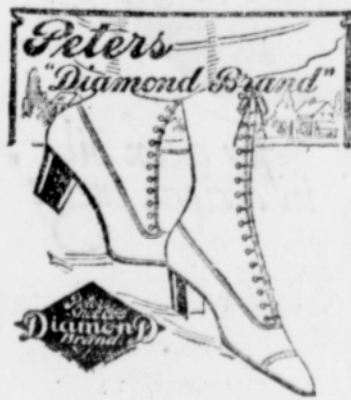

If you are making up your Christmas shopping list and wondering just what is going to be the nicest thing for each person you have in mind, perhaps these suggestions will help.

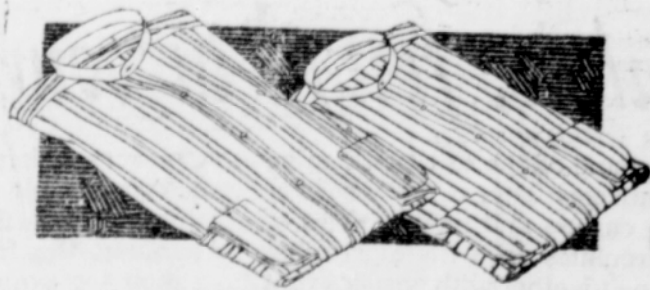
