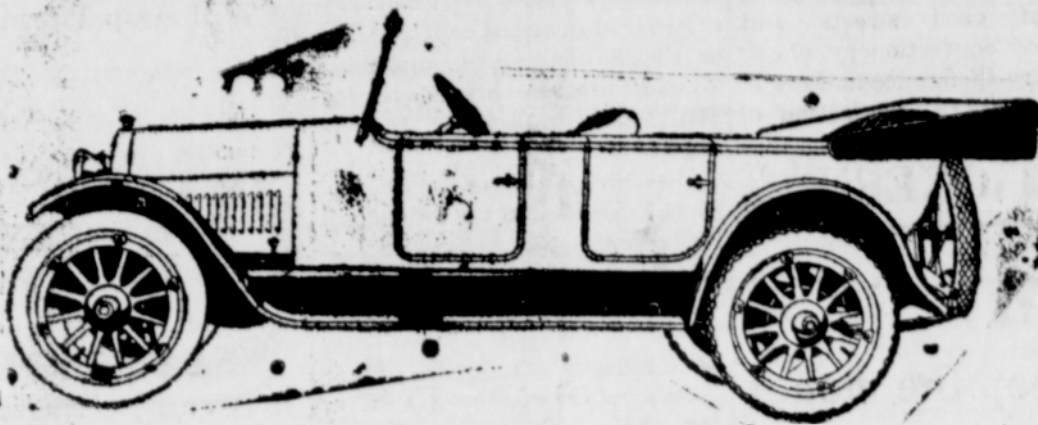

Humidity in Surgery.

Investigations made in several Bos-
ton hospitals by Dr. Ellsworth Hunt-
ington seem to indicate that for sur-
gical operations, the best condition
of the atmosphere is high humidity, 80
per cent or more, directly after opera-
tions, and moderate humidity, about
90 per cent, at a temperature of 64
degrees Fahrenheit, a few days later.
Doctor Huntington points out that, if
these results are accepted, there is no
reason why the optimum conditions
of temperature and humidity should
not be produced artificially in hos-
pitals, causing a probable improve-
ment in not less than 20 per cent in
the results of operations.
