Poultry Demonstration at William's Farm

Schedule for the poultry culling demonstration which will begin in Linn county on August 4 has been announced by the county agent who is sending out the dates and instructions for the work to all poultry project leaders, community chairmen and co-operators.

Owners of flocks are asked to keep a careful record of eggs from the entire flock for seven days prior to the culling demonstration. At culling time the culls should be kept away from the select fowls and a record of eggs made for the seven succeeding days, the instructions read. This record should then be sent to the county agent. The hens should be kept in a coop by the co-operators on the day of the demonstration.

On the schedule for the culling demonstrations, including the names of the demonstrators, project leader and community chairman appears for Aug. 4th, 9 a. m.—Lake Creek at the Clarence Williams place. H. E. Cosby, demonstrator; O. G. Coldiron, project leader; and C. R. Evans, community chairman.

This is an excellent opportunity for the poultry raisers of this community to obtain the necessary knowledge to improve their flocks and make the chicken business a paying one. Come, bring your basket dinner, and further this movement by your attendance.

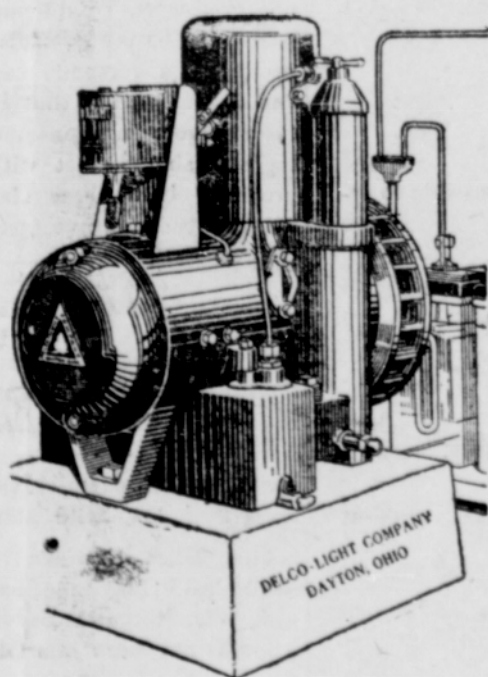
