Our economic life ought to be so organized, and in time will be so organized, that every man, whatever his task or calling, will have time for the development of his higher life. No human being ought to be debarred from such opportunity. Every man and woman in every line of work should have time for this.

When we become wise enough to see this, labor will take on its true dignity and our labor men will do finer work and more work than ever hefore. I am glad, therefore that William Green the present wise and able president of the American Federation of Labor, is emphasizing this No Charge for Consultation as a matter to be kept in view and brought about in due time.

Wholesome recreation and amateur sport may have its proper place on Sunday, provided it does not take the place of prayer and worship. Our sports and recreations are in their own proper place as truly acceptable and pleasing to God as our prayers and our worship, but it is not right for us to give to recreation the hours that belong to worship. The instinct for play is as divinely implanted in human nature as the instinct for work and the instinct for worship.
