ues, at 4.15, Mrs. Hill breathed her last.

Mrs. Hill was Amanda J., daughter of Martin A. Ludewick and wife of Irving, Ill. where she married A. J. Hill in 1886, when she was 23 years old. They had three children, Glenn E. of Eugene and Mrs. B. R. Holt and Carl J. Hill of Halsey. These and four grandchildren survive.

The Hills came to Oregon in 1890, returned to Illinois in 1899, and in 1906 came back to this state. They have resided in Linn county ever since.

Had Mrs. Hill lived three days longer she would have been 64. Her funeral was at the Methodist church yesterday afternoon.

When Miss Willamina Corcoran began to cough, in 1925, tuberculosis, of which her older sister had died at their home, was soon suspected. She went to the state hospital at Salem. Nearly a year ago her father built comfortable quarters for her outside the residence, where there was much fresh air and sunshine, and brought her home, where she could enjoy the ministrations of loved ones. In the long summer days of sunshine the disease did not make much progress. In fact, the girl rallied and visited near-by neighbors. But the past winter has had less sunshine than usual, and direct sunshine is sword and shield in a battle with tuberculosis.

The end came Sunday morning about 8. The funeral was at the Church of Christ Tuesday afternoon.

Deceased was 19 years old the 10th of last February.

Willamina's was one of those genial spirits which make friends of all who come in contact with her. Her cheerful mein was maintained through all the weary months of invalidism.

Even when it was correctly believed that her last day had arrived, seeing tears in her mother's eyes, she said: "Don't cry, mother; I am ready to die. Nobody was ever more ready to die than I am."
