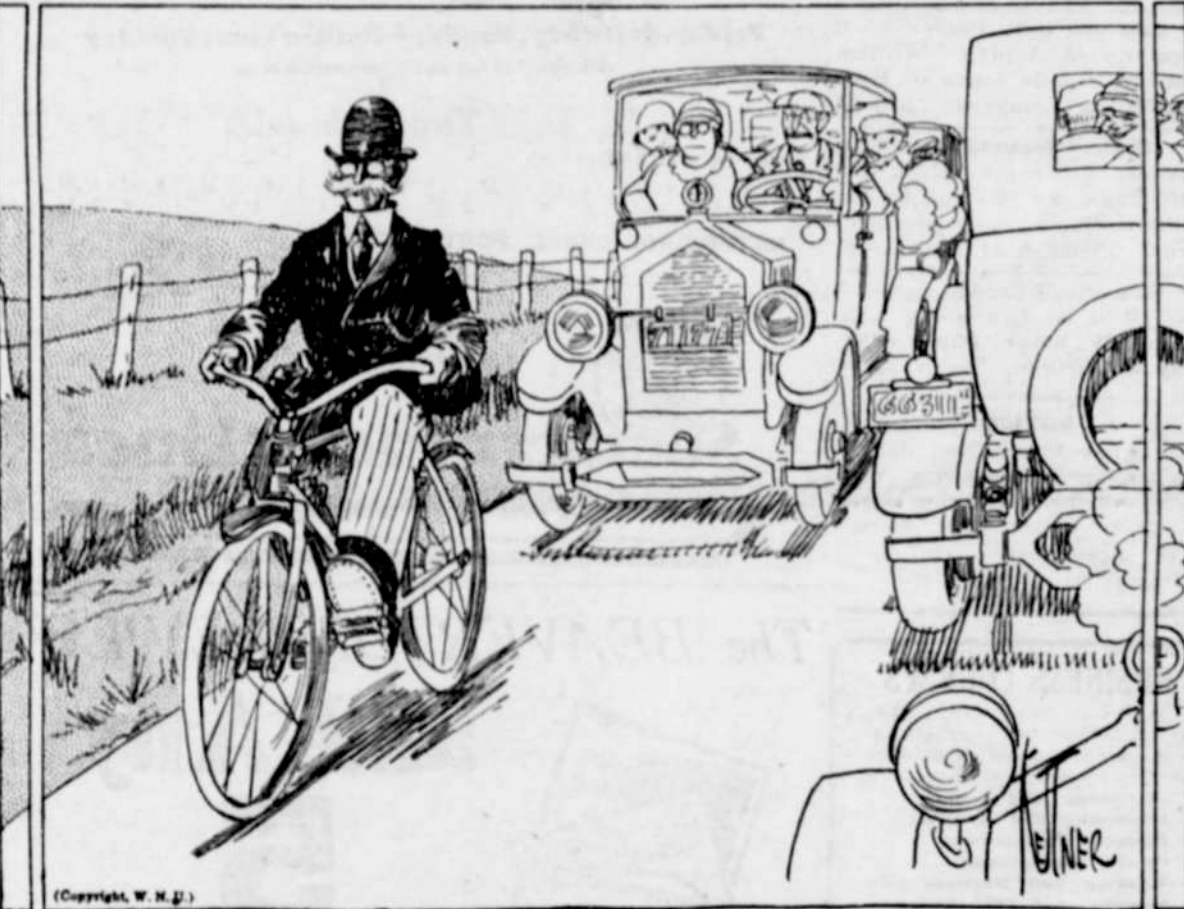

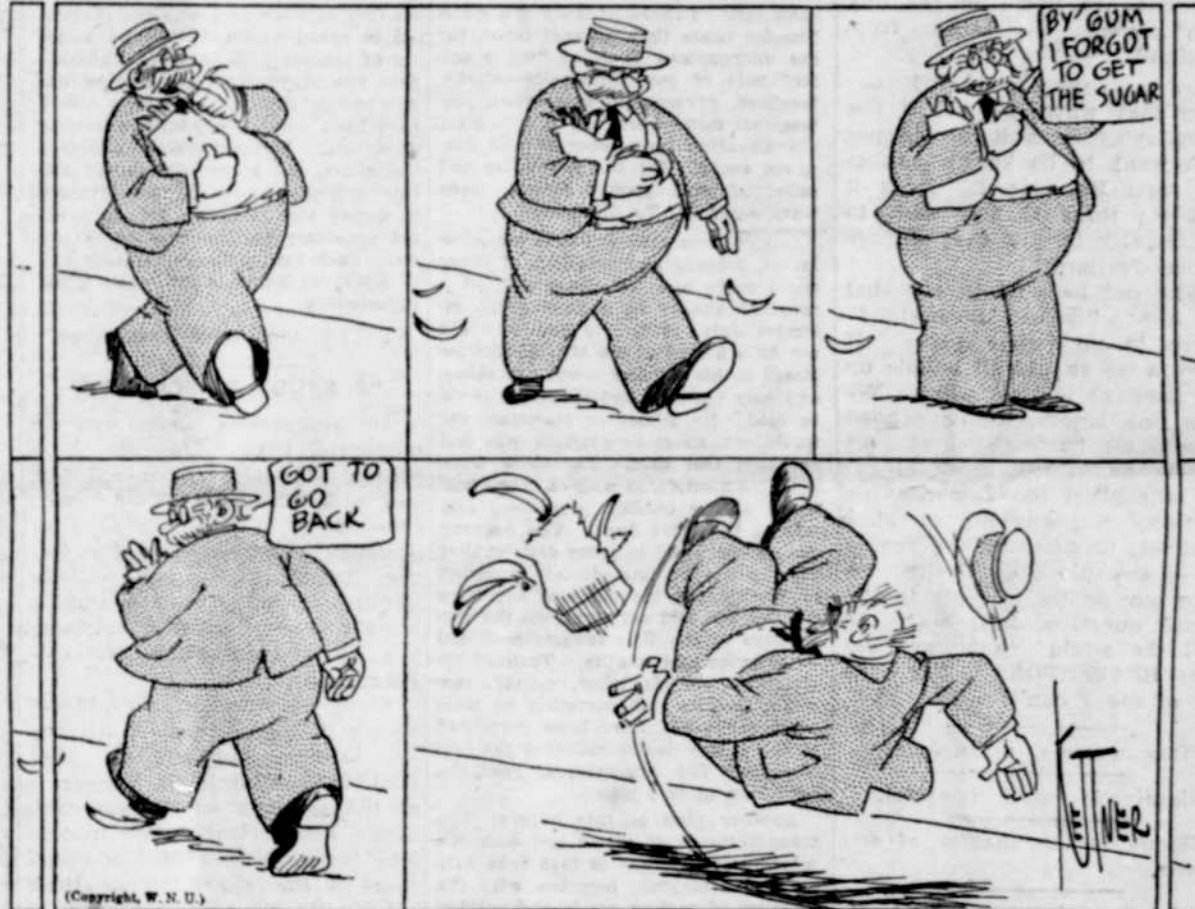

Famous Triumphal Arch

The Arc de Triomphe, the largest triumphal arch of modern times, standing on the Place de l'Etoile at the west end of the Champs Elysees, was dedicated by Napoleon I in commemoration of the campaigns of the Grande Armee. The corner stone was laid August 15, 1806. On the downfall of Napoleon work was suspended, and the structure was not completed until 1836, under Louis Philippe. It is 122 feet high, 138 feet wide and 68 feet deep. The arch is elaborately carved with colossal figures in high relief, and on it are inscribed the names of 96 of Napoleon's victories and 384 of his generals.
