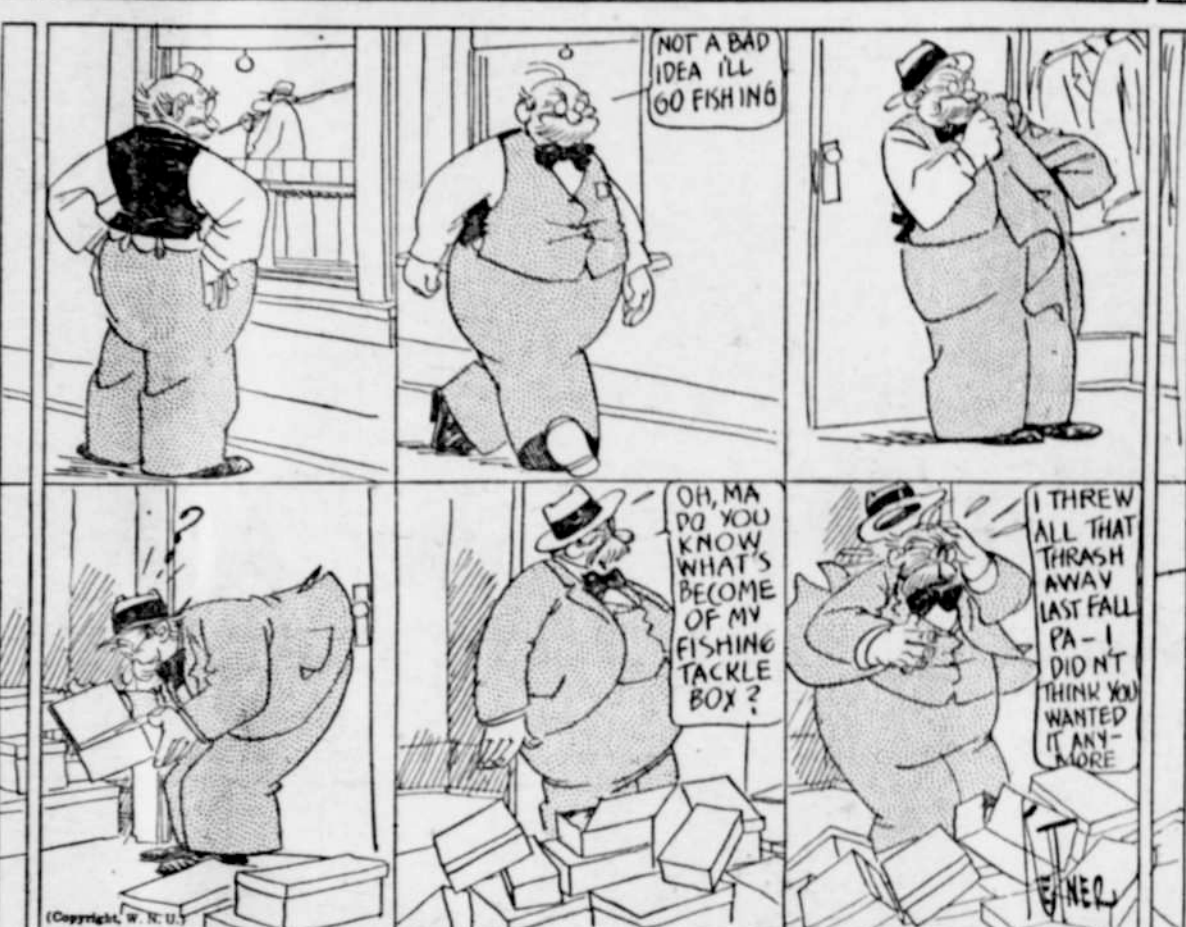

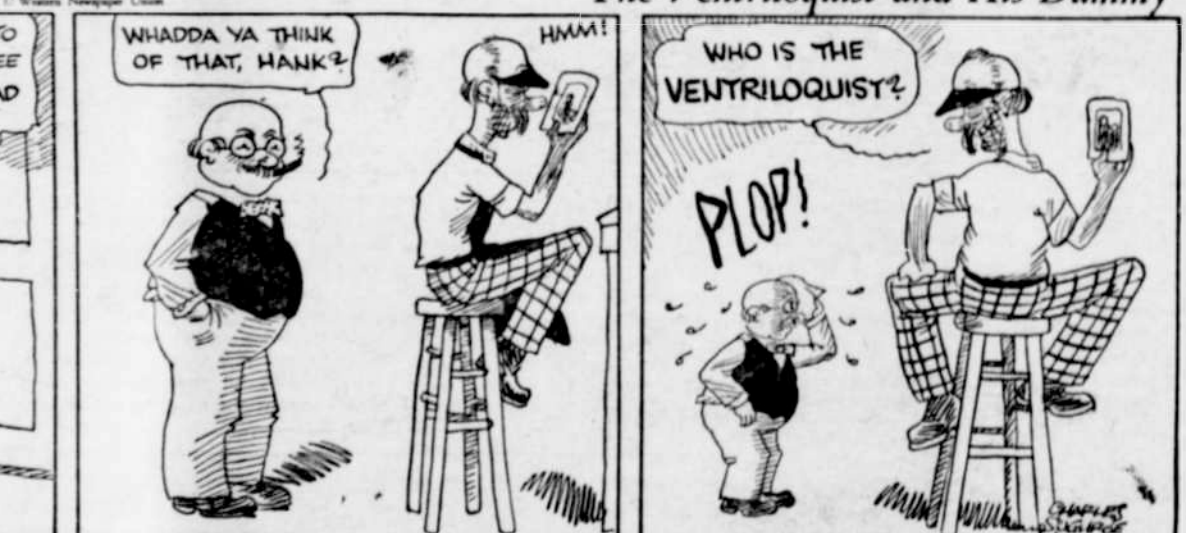

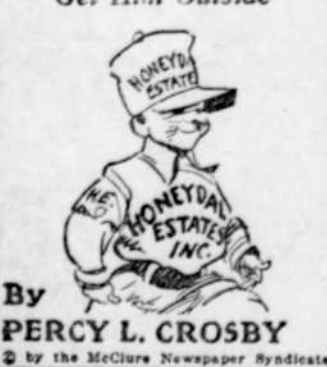

Uses for Vulcanite
