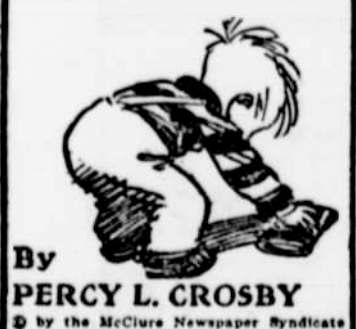

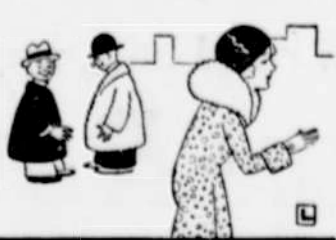

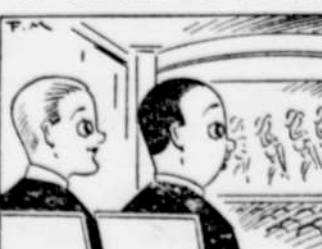
## A Mere Trifle
