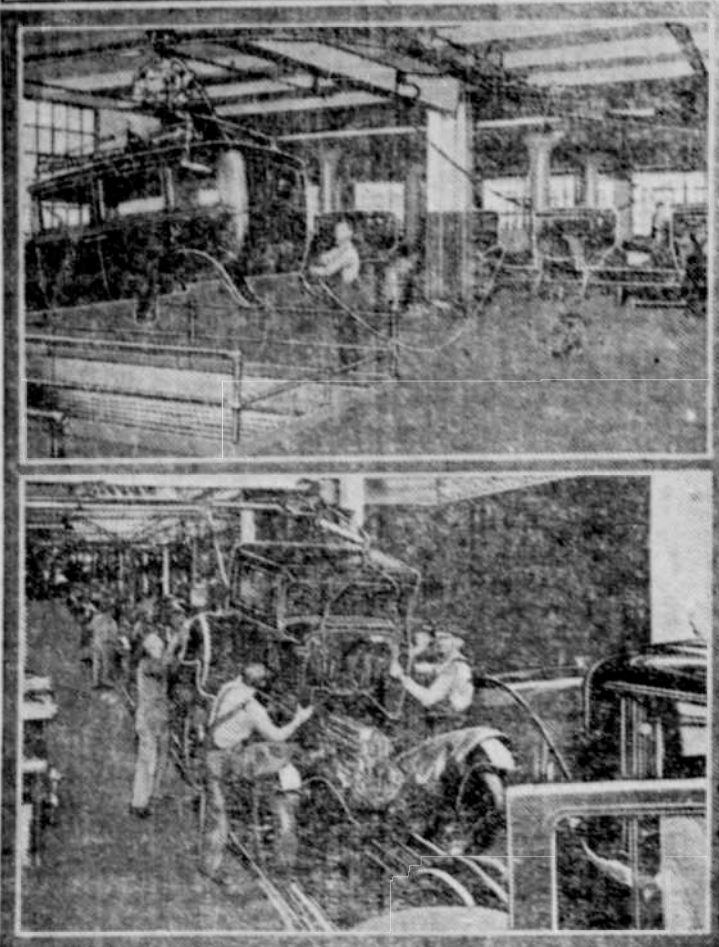


**Perfect Timing Necessary In Factory**

**FARM REMINDERS**

Where spidermites are found on deciduous fruit trees this time of the year, diluted summer oil emulsion, 1 to 1 1/2 gallons to 100 gallons of water, is recommended by the Oregon Experiment station as a spray. It is a contact spray and to be effective must touch the mites, which are found on the under sides of the leaves.

Bachelor buttons, or French pinks, as they are often called, are the most numerous weed seeds found in western Oregon crops, and Russian thistle holds the honors for the eastern part of the state, at least in the alfalfa fields, according to Miss Letha Bunting of Oregon State college, whose job it is to run purity and germination tests on Oregon's \$150,000,000 seed crop.

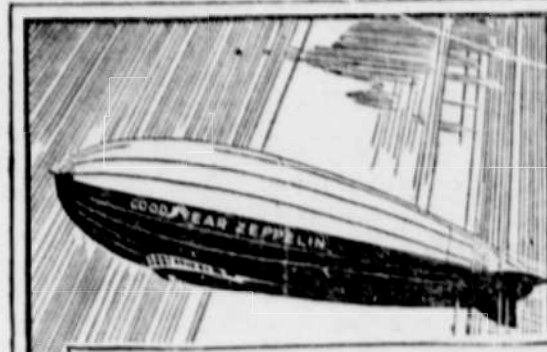

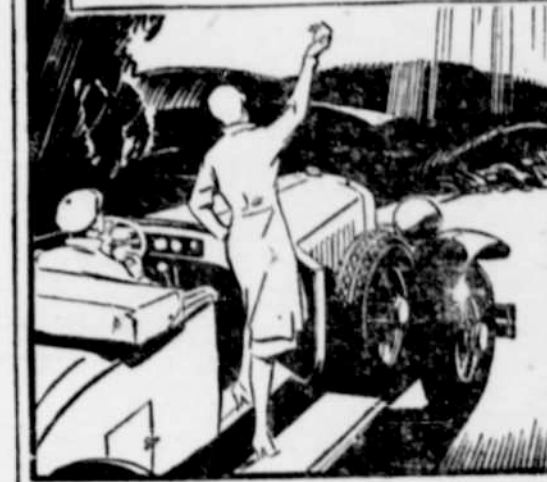

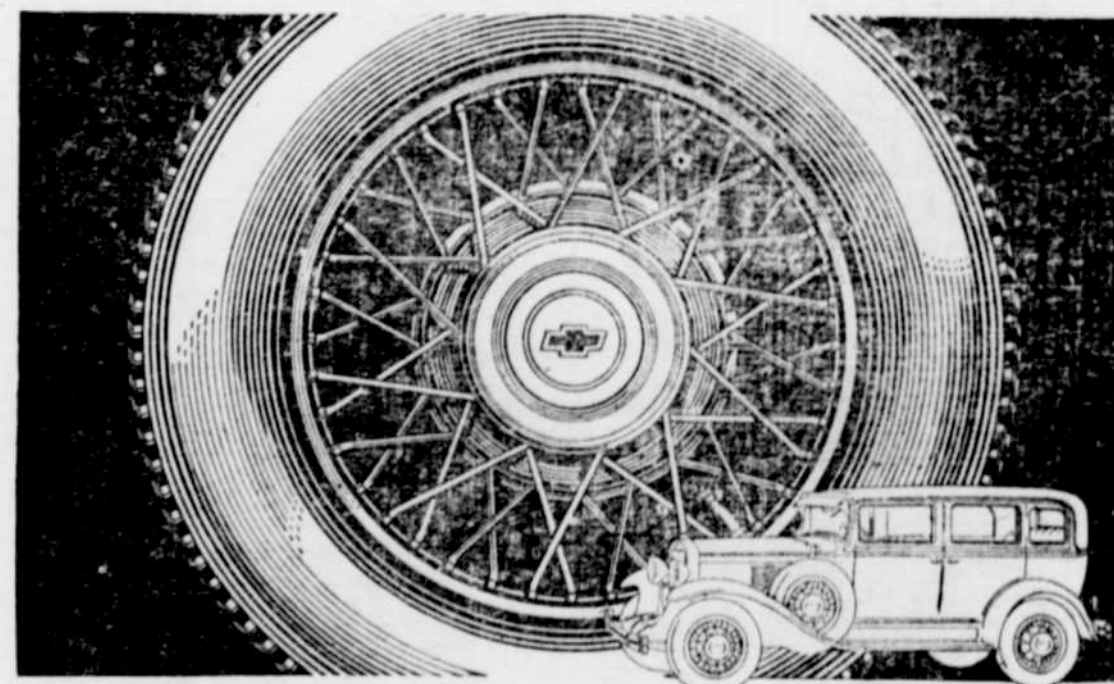
