## AGRICULTURAL DEPT. WILL BE FORMED

Inquiries concerning the creation of the new State Department of Agriculture are numerous. Comment upon the law creating it is generally very favorable.

The first step in the organization will be the Governor's appointment of a Director in whom shall be centered chief responsibility for the success of the Department. Following his appointment the Director shall, as provided by the law creating the Department, organize the work under five divisions: (1) administration, (2) plant industry, (3) animal industry, (4) foods and dairies, (5) markets, grades and standards.

Over each of these divisions there will be an officer designated Chief of his division, appointed by the Governor with the consent of the Chief Executive. The Director will be ex-officio Chief of the division of administration.

The office of the State Dairy and Food Commission will be retained by the present commissioner until the expiration of his elective term, when the appointment of Chief of this division will be made under the new Department. It is provided by the law creating it that this new State Department will go into effect July 1, 1931.
