



WHAT'ALL YOU HAVE, MAYBE IT'S HERE!

When Parties Get Growing Pains
If your parties get growing pains—don't let it worry you! If you've invited four guests and they bring four more—shrug it off! If Junior and Joan bring half a dozen young things home to feast, and an extra dozen drop in you can "grin and bear it"—with rice! Let a fluffy mound of rice expand that platter of meat balls, topped with a cherry red tomato sauce; or add it to leftover vegetables to make a salad stretch. If it's creamed chicken for four—rice makes it satisfy 8! It stretches as far as your own imagination will go—and that's the limit!

MARSHMALLOW FROSTING IS ELEGANT

Fluffy marshmallow frosting, firm and dry on the outside, but soft and smooth inside, tops your party cake perfectly when you make it this way:

Marshmallow Frosting

1-3 cups sugar
1/2 cup cold water
6 marshmallows
1 egg white
1 tbsp. white corn syrup (coloring optional)
Boil sugar, water and corn syrup until syrup spins a thread. Pour slowly onto stiffly beaten egg white; add marshmallows, and continue beating until icing "piles up." The corn syrup will keep your frosting smooth and the secret of keeping it from getting grainy.

BANANA CREAM PIE

1 1/2 cups milk
1/4 cup sugar
1/4 tsp. salt
3 tbsps. flour
1 egg yolk
1 tbsp. butter
4 bananas
1/4 tsp. vanilla extract or 1/2 tsp. lemon extract
1 9-inch pie shell
Whipped cream or meringue
Scald one cup of the milk over hot water. Mix together the sugar, salt, and flour. Add 1/2 cup of cold milk slowly, stirring until mixture is smooth. Stir into hot milk. Cook until thickened, stirring constantly. Cover and let cook for about three minutes. Stir a little of the hot milk mixture into the egg yolk, and add this to the hot mixture. Cook one minute longer. Add butter and flau-

vorine. Allow mixture to cool. Fill pie shell with alternate layers of sliced bananas and cooked filling. Top with whipped cream or meringue. Makes one 9-inch pie.

MUFFINS MAKE THE LENTEN MEAL

Piping hot muffins, rich with beautiful golden dates will make the meal, however restricted the Lenten menu. For breakfast try these Bran Health Muffins on your Tommy Tuckers.

Bran Health Muffins

1 cup flour
1 tsp. salt
4 tbsps. baking powder
1 cup bran
1 tbsp. molasses
1/2 doz. dates, sliced
1 cup milk
2 tbsps. salad oil
Sift white flour, baking powder, and salt together in a mixing bowl; add bran. Mix the sliced dates through the dry ingredients with finger tips. Beat egg slightly; add milk, and stir mixture into dry ingredients. Add molasses and salad oil and stir as little as possible to mix. Fill well-oiled muffin pans two-thirds full. Bake in hot oven (400° F.) for 25 to 30 minutes. 12 medium sized muffins.

If you're "in a fever" about the first course—here's the remedy! If you're in a pet about dessert—the same recipe will calm you down; and if you're just anxious to try something new with the meat—you're right—it's the answer!

Grapefruit Ice

2 cups water
1 1/4 cups sugar
2 tbsps. gelatin
2 tbsps. cold water
2 tbsps. lemon juice
1 cup grapefruit juice
1 egg white, beaten stiff
Soften gelatin in cold water. Boil sugar and water together for 5 minutes. Add softened gelatin to the hot syrup. Cool. Add fruit juices and egg white. Pour into freezing trays and freeze at lowest temperature. After it starts to freeze, stir mixture in the tray so that the egg white will become mixed through. Delicious served with fruit cup, as a meat garnish or a dessert. Serves 6 to 8.
