Strange Industries In China.

In Taichow our correspondent saw some strange industries. One was the keeping of large stags, as big as a fair sized horse, reared for the sake of their horns, which are cut off every summer and sold for as much as \$35 gold for use as medicine. The horn is soft, and the softer it is when removed the higher the price realized. The other was the raising of the machi, a sort of large pheasant, the tail feathers of which are very valuable, as they are needed for the dress hats of mandarins. Timber is very plentiful in this district and is sent away by raft to all parts.—North China News.

Writing on Wood.

Some persons who make a study of the subject are of the opinion that the first writing was upon thin pieces of wood. From their convenience this seems probable. Such boards were used at an early period by the Greeks and Romans and were frequently covered with wax, which was, of course, more easily written upon than the bare wood. Where wax was used errors were readily erased by rubbing with the blunt end of the piece of metal which served for a pen. To make the writing more visible it appears that some black substance was smeared over the surface of the white wax and remained in the scratched marks.

The Bronx In New York.

Even in New York comparatively few residents know the origin of the name Bronx. It came from an early settler, Jonas Bronck, who, with two companions, sailed from Holland in the private armed ship Fire of Troy and arrived in New Amsterdam in July, 1639. Bronck at once obtained from the Dutch West India company a grant of 500 acres of land in what is now Westchester county, "lying between the Great Kill" (the Harlem river) "and the Ahquahung" (the Bronx river). An old "Tracing of Broncksland" is still preserved in the office of the secretary of state at Albany, and the location of Jonas Bronck's house is shown thereon.
